

The Bureau has advised as follows:

All investigation must be handled under the personal direction of the SAC. Leads are to be afforded immediate, thorough imaginative attention. Exhaust all possibilities from such leads as any one lead could result in the solution of this important investigation. SAC will be held personally responsible for any failure to promptly and thoroughly handle investigations in this matter.

This is a civil rights investigation to identify the person or persons responsible for the assassination in Memphis, Tennessee, on 4/4/68.

The pertinent periods in this investigation are 3/29-30/68 in Birmingham, Alabama, and 4/4/68 in Memphis, Tennessee. In the event any data is developed re suspects, if offices can establish whereabouts of suspects on above dates, this may eliminate the suspect. If this cannot be done, efforts should be made to secure photographs of suspects in question and forward photos to Memphis and Birmingham for possible eliminate Particent descriptive data should be included with photos.

If unable to eliminate on the basis of established whereabouts in pertinent periods, interested offices should make efforts to secure fingerprints of suspect in question and submit same to Bureau for elimination.



In addition to descriptive data re the suspect in reference memo, this white male had blue or green eyes, medium build, average complexion, smooth; hair combed straight back; general physical appearance, neat. Possibility exists that this suspect is a non-smoker. Indications were that this suspect rented the room between 3:00 and 3:30 p.m., 4/4/68, and departed that room shortly after 6:00 p.m. No matches or cigarettes were found during that period.

Results of investigation must be promptly furnished to the Bureau, Memphis, and Birmingham.

Butel to All Continents! Offices, 4/9/68, stated as follows:

Among articles recovered at the scene of shooting, apparently abandoned by Unsub, were a pair of brownish, checkered print undershorts and white Jockey tee shirt, bearing cloth laundry tags. These tags were made by a Thermo Seal marking machine manufactured by the Textile Marking Machine Company of Syracuse, New York. These tags are 1/4 inch wide and 1 1/16 inch long, red in color and bear marking which appears to be "O Two B Dash Six" or "D Two B Dash Six". Only a portion of the first character is present on each tag, and this character is cut on a slight bias. No other visible laundry marks were found on either garment.

Immediate checks of logical laundries suggested by Textile Marking Company have, to date, been unproductive.

All Offices should immediately telephonically contact all laundries vour Divisions to identify the laundry using this code and west tags in the laundries developed.

If pertinent laundry identified, immediately advise the Bureau telephonically.

This must be given Top Priority Handling to insure that these checks are immediately run out.

King Slayer Hunt Widens Into Mexico

The assassin of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., may have fled the country, according to indications Tuesday. The FBI has asked Mexican authorities to aid

in the search.

A police spokesman in Mexico City said Monday that a drawing of the suspect, a composite of descriptions by persons who saw a white lodger believed to be the sniper in the Memphis rooming house from where Dr. King was shot, has been distributed in Mexico and at border points.

United States Attorney Gen. Ramsey Clark, in Washington, said Monday the "trail has lengthened" since Friday, the day after Dr. King was slain.

The assassin was described by the landlady who rented him a room the day of the slaying as a man with a sharp nose, square chin, black hair receding on the sides, and "a silly smile." He is about six feet tall and between 26 and 32 years old, witnesses
