Other Offices receiving copies of this airtel were not furnished rerep and so the following background information is being set forth to assist these Offices in conducting the requested investigation:

Investigation has determined that the subject, using the name of ERIC GALT, left Los Angeles, Calif., on 12/15/67, driving his Mustang automobile, in the company of CHARLES J. STEIN, of Los Angeles. STEIN had formerly been a resident of New Orleans and the alleged purpose of this trip was for STEIN to pick up two children of his sister's who were residing in New Orleans and return them to California. According to STEIN, they arrived in New Orleans on 12/17/67 and left New Orleans on 12/19/67. STEIN stayed with relatives and investigation has determined that subject registered at the Provincial Motel, 1024 Chartres Street, New Orleans, on 12/17/67 as ERIC S. GALT and was assigned room 126. The registration card indicated GALT's automobile to be a Mustang bearing Alabama license 1-38993 and his address as 2608 Highland Avenue, Birmingham, Ala. The subject, as GALT, stayed at the motel until 12/19/67 when he checked out.

Interviews of motel employees in regards to the subject have been negative in that they cannot recall him.

There is set forth under a caption for each Office the identity or identities of persons staying at the Provincial Motel from 12/17 through 19/67. The identities of these persons were obtained from the motel registration cards as well as other information which is set forth under the name. The date listed under each name is the date the individual or individuals stayed at the motel. Each Office should locate and interview these individuals for any knowledge or contact they may have had with the subject. Various photographs of JAMES EARL RAY, which have been furnished to all Offices, should be displayed to these individuals to ascertain if they recall RAY.

In order to assist Memphis, the Office of Origin in this matter, each Office should set forth the results of this investigation in report form with copies of the reports designated for the Bureau and Memphis.

In the preparation of these reports, it is suggested that an appropriate predication for this part of the investigation be utilized in the details prior to reporting the results of contacts with these individuals. As an example, the following information might be used for this predication:

Too Many Loose Ends

James Earl Ray has pleaded guilty to the charge of murdering Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. He has been sentenced to 99 years.

But the case is far from over. The word, "conspiracy," is on the tongues of those who were most closely involved.

The judge who presided at the two-hour trial said that although "it has not been established at this time there was any conspiracy" by Ray and others to kill Dr. King, "this is not conclusive evidence that there was no conspiracy."

Ray said he didn't agree with "the theory that there was no conspiracy."

Press reports quote a Justice Department spokesman as saying that "the investigation into the original allegations of a conspiracy is still open."

The original federal warrant filed by the FBI last April 17 is still in effect. It charged that a man identified as Eric Starvo Galt had "conspired with an individual whom he alleged to be his brother" against Dr. King.

These words, together with questions about the apparent careful planning for flight immediately after the crime and about the financing of Ray's international travels, leave too many loose ends in the King assassination.

Fortunately, the investigation remains in the hands of the FBI. If there are conspirators, the agency should be able to find them. They cannot draw an easy breath as long as they live.

As for Ray's punishment, the most that can be said for it is that he will be behind bars and possibly in a mood to testify if and when there are further developments. If ever a crime called for capital punishment, this one did. The fact that Ray got off with less does not sit well, however useful Ray may be in trials yet to come.
