





The following investigation was conducted by SAs NILE A. DUKE and JAMES H. REEVES, JR.

On 4/10/68, KAREN ADAMS, 6706 McPherson Boulevard, Pittsburgh, Second Floor, stated she has lived at this address for one year. She stated that the name R. D. LOHMEYER is completely unfamiliar to her.

On 4/10/68, VICTOR OLMSTEAD, 6706 McPherson Boulevard, First Floor, stated he has lived at this address since October, 1966. He stated the name P. D. LOHMEYER is completely unfamiliar to him. Mr. OLMSTEAD said the house he is renting is owned by BLANCHE GRIFFIN and that he does not know her address and only pays his rent to her when she knocks on the door.

It is to be noted that both KAREN ADAMS and VICTOR OLMSTEAD are Negroes, and that the area surrounding 6706 McPherson Boulevard is inhabitated by primarily Negro individuals.

Mr. G. L. MONET, Postal Inspector, Pittsburgh, Pa., caused a search of his records to be made for a change of address for P. D. LOHMEYER, 6706 McPherson Boulevard. Mr. MONET stated he talked with his carrier for this particular area and that the carrier could not recall such an individual. He further advised that a search of his records for the past three years failed to reflect a change of address for P. D. LOHMEYER. He stated that any changes of address over three years old is destroyed.

On 4/10/68, Mrs. ANTHONY DEIULUS, 815 Fulton Place, Mount Oliver, stated that the name VERA LOHMEYER is unfamiliar to her. She stated she had lived at this address for four

years and had purchased her house from one DOROTHY REUESCHE.

On 4/10/68, DOROTHY REUESCHE, Pittsburgh National Bank, Carrick Office, Carrick, Pa., advised that VERA LOHMEYER had committed suicide on 12/12/61. REUESCHE said she knew the LOHMEYER family and that VERA did not have any brothers or sisters. She did recall her having an uncle, ED LOHMEYER, Penn Hills, Pa., who is in his fifties and who has been seriously ill for some time.

On 4/10/68, THOMAS A. MC QUAIDE, Chief, Identification Section, Pittsburgh Police Department, CLARENCE J. KLEIN, Chief Identification Officer, Allegheny County Detective Bureau, and Mrs. JEAN RODRIGUEZ, Receptionist, Credit Bureau, Inc., all of Pittsburgh, Pa., advised that their respective files were all negative concerning VERA LOHMEYER and P. D. EOHMEYER.

A check of yellow sections of all telephone directories covering communities in Mineral, Hampshire, Morgan, and Jefferson Counties, W. Va., was made and no laundry was listed.

In Berkeley County, W. Va., two laundries were located as follows:

GRANT SEABRIGHT, Manager, Martinsburg Laundry, on 4/11/68, said his firm does not use a thermo seal marking machine.

On 4/11/68, S. L. ROCKWELL, Rockwell Cleaners and Launderers, said his firm does use a thermo seal marking machine, but that the coding "O2B-6" or "D2B-6" is not used by his firm.

ROCKWELL added, for possible assistance, that there are ten colors used and available to firms that use the thermo seal machine, but he does not use the red color; that in his operations only five colors are used; and that he changes the color of the marking with every lot. He said that his code numbers are broken into the lot number, an alphabetical letter for the week, and a bundle number, running from one to twenty. He said he knows no one in the eastern section of West Virginia who uses a thermo seal machine, and believes the closest is at York, Pa.


