Mrs. RUTH HARRIS, Beaver, Pa., advised that sometime during the week prior to 4/13/68, at exactly 4:50 a.m., she received a telephone call from an individual whom she did not initially recognize by his voice, but he mentioned CAROL, and she then determined it to be MORRIS SKAGGS. She stated she talked to another individual who was with SKAGGS, but told them she did not want to talk to them and hung up. INVESTIGATION DISCLOSED THAT GALT PURCHASED THIS CAR FROM A PRIVATE CITIZEN IN BIRMINGHAM ON AUGUST 30, 1967. THE MUSTANG'S ODOMETER SHOWED THAT IT HAD BEEN DRIVEN MORE THAN 19,000 MILES BETWEEN LATE AUGUST, 1967, AND EARLY APRIL, 1968.

ACCORDING TO MR. GALT LEFT LOS ANGELES ON DECEMBER 15, 1967, AND DROVE HIS WHITE MUSTANG TO NEW ORLEANS, WHERE HE CLAIMED HE CONTACTED EITHER AN ENGINEERING OR A CONTRACTING FIRM. HE LEFT NEW ORLEANS ON DECEMBER 19TH AND ARRIVED BACK IN LOS ANGELES ON DECEMBER 21, 1967.

WHILE IN THE LOS ANGELES AREA EARLY THIS YEAR, GALT TOOK A COURSE AT A SCHOOL OF BARTENDING AND WAS GRADUATED ON MARCH 2, 1968.

THE FUGITIVE IS DESCRIBED AS WHITE MALE. HE IS APPROXIMATELY 5 FEET 8 INCHES TO 5 FEET 11 INCHES TALL AND WEIGHS BETWEEN 160 AND 175 POUNDS. HE IS SAID TO BE A NEAT DRESSER AND HAS A MEDIUM BUILD.

On 4-18-68, Mrs. SHERRY HINSON, 336 Norway Ave., Huntington, W.Va., telephone number C/O Dr. JOHN PLOTT, 523-3804, telephonically contacted the Pgh. office to furnish the following information:

Mrs. HINSON advised that on 4-13-68, she traveled by Greyhound Bus Lines from Huntington, W.Va., to Lancaster, Ohio. She stated that at about 7:30PM either in Portsmouth, Ohio, or Ashland, Ky., a white male individual boarded the bus and sat beside her. He engaged in a conversation with her at which time he stated he was going to Detroit, Mich. to visit his brother; that he was from Pikeville, Ky., Harlan County. This individual also stated that his brother had just had a Mustang car stolen from him last week.

Mrs. HINSON advised that upon viewing the photograph of ERIC STARVO GALT in the local papers this date, she believes that the above mentioned individual bore a ~~strong~~ resemblance to that of GALT. She stated that she was skeptical of his story, which was that he was in the Marines stationed at Ft Knox; that he had been in Vietnam in 1958; that he also served in Berlin, and that his brother-in-law was the well known western music personality CLET ATKINS of Knoxville, Tenn.

Mrs. HINSON described the man as being a white male, 35 to 36 years old, 5'11" to 6', 190 lbs., sun tan complexion, black hair, tattoo "H.B." on right hand and L O V E on ~~left~~ hand. She stated this man had been drinking and smoked cigarettes. She stated he asked her to write to him and she refused, however she did give him her name and address. She believes that it could be possible that he would write to her or contact her at a future date. If he does and she determines any identifying data she will furnish same to this office.

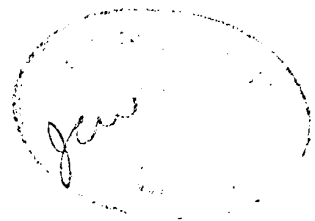

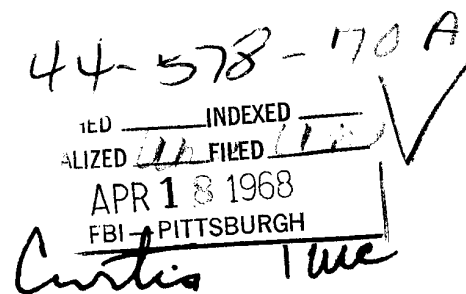
