At 8:40 pm, 5-7-68, Mr. Milton George McGauhey, 119 Camp Council Road, Phoenixville, Pa., telephone 933-2487, called this office and advised that while he was at the Valley Forge General Hospital, Friday, 5-3-68, at 1:30 PM, there was a man standing in front of McGauhey who he said looked exactly like the man that was ~~XXXXX~~ wanted for the slaying of Dr. Martin Luther King. McGauhey stated that he saw the new photos of the subject on the TV, tonight, and said that they looked just like the man at the hospital.

McGauhey stated that he was there to see a Dr. Reitsma and that that man in front of him also saw this doctor. McGauhey stated that the man was in with the doctor till 1:45 PM, at which time the man came out and started talking to McGauhey. When McGauhey came out of the doctors office, the man was talking on the phone, and was waiting at the Pharmacy. McGauhey said that he saw the older photos of Ray and said that this man did not look like the older photos.

He does state that the man looked like the new photos, that he saw tonight on TV. He describes the man as follows: Six feet, 200 lbs., dark hair, short nose, 30-35 years, medium comp., wearing a brown suit and very talkative.

McGauhey states that he can be reached, all day, at his house.

The following investigation was conducted on 5/6/68:

Mr. FLOYD HAAKE, R.D. 1, Stevens, Pa., stated he had observed an individual in the Oriole Social Club, Denver, Pa. on May 5, 1968 who had a facial resemblance to the composite photograph published of the assassin of MARTIN LUTHER KING, and had similar physical description. This individual, called "Rebel" by some of his associates at the Social Club, bragged about his southern origin, and claimed he was employed by an electrical construction company putting electric lines into Ephrata, Pa., and was residing at the Reamstown Inn, Ephrata.

RICHARD STICK, Manager, Reamstown Inn, Ephrata, Pa., advised that an A. LEWIS, from Florida, an employee of the Ephrata Power & Light Co., checked into the Inn on April 18, 1968 and is currently residing there.

JANE FASNACHT, Borough Hall, Ephrata, Pa., stated that the Buck Line Corporation, 1212 Moss St., Reading, Pa., an electrical contractor, is putting new power lines into the electrical system which serves Ephrata Borough. She stated that Ephrata Borough has no record of an A. LEWIS employed on that project, but stated if LEWIS is employed on the project, Buck Line Corporation would have him on the payroll.

Being forwarded under separate cover is a supply of newspaper mats and proofs for expeditious distribution to all cooperative daily and weekly newspapers in your territory. Additional publications such as shoppers' guides should not be overlooked in obtaining the greatest possible publicity regarding this fugitive.

In most cases, these mats and proofs may be distributed by mail but when circumstances warrant they may be personally delivered by Special Agents. A form letter over the signature of the Special Agent in Charge may be utilized in distributing this material by mail and this letter should point out that the FBI is requesting the aid of the Nation's press in bringing about the prompt apprehension of this badly sought fugitive.

Prompt distribution should be made and additional supplies, if needed, are available at the Bureau. The following number of mats and proofs are being forwarded to your office under separate cover: 300.

As an additional means of securing widespread publicity concerning Ray, offices covering the place of publication of magazines which have previously cooperated in publicizing FBI fugitives should request the assistance of such publications in carrying an article on captioned fugitive. The Bureau press release, copies of which are available in each office, along with a glossy photograph of this fugitive can be furnished. The earliest possible utilization of this material should be encouraged and special attention should be given to publications aimed at minority groups?

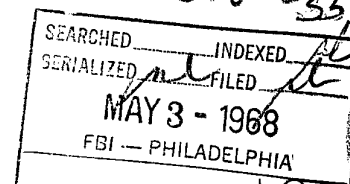

MRS. SPATZ stated this phone call was from her son, RICHARD GUSTAV SPATZ, who resides in Alleghany, Calif. He is age 40, 5'9", 180#, dark hair and medium complexion, single and reportedly employed as a building manager in the vicinity of Alleghany, Calif. He formerly attended Temple University, Philadelphia, Pa. where he majored in pre-law and later worked as a building manager in New York City before moving to California. He has had very limited contact with his family during the past several years so that the exact nature of his employment is not known to them.

MRS. SPATZ said her son regularly telephones home every several months to insure the family forward to him the dividend checks which are mailed to him at the family Sharon Hill address. These dividend checks are from American Telephone and Telegraph Co. and her son has 100 shares of stock in that company. She beleives this telephone call on 12/12/67 was in connection with the forwarding of a dividend check but she could not be certain at this time.

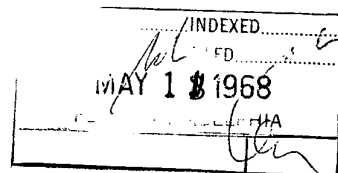
