
SAS ROLAND M. COCKER and JOHN L. LYNCH responded to the Clarendon Motor Hotel Court and contacted Mr. GOFF, who advised that he noticed an individual in his motor court lobby at approximately 7 A.M., on the morning of 4/18/68 by himself, and described him as a white male, 5'10" - 5'11", dark hair, well dressed wearing a light gray suit.

Mr. GOFF mentioned that on the evening of 4/18/68, he observed the FBI photo of GOFF appearing in the "Evening star" newspaper, and felt compelled to call this to the attention of the FBI.

Mr. GOFF advised that he has no one staying at the motor court by the name of GALT, HARVEY LOWMYER or JOHN WILLARD, the aliases of GALT. Mr. GOFF, thereafter, made available to SAs LYNCH and COCKER the registration cards for all residents of the motel for the period 4/18 - 19/68. A review of these registration cards reflected no identifiable name with that of the subject, GALT, or his aliases.

There were no registered guests from Memphis or Atlanta area. Mr. GOFF mentioned that he did not know if this individual was a guest or if he had just stopped in the motel.

A surveillance was thereafter undertaken for the remainder of the morning, and the "lookalike" did not reappear in the lounge. Mr. GOFF thereafter made arrangements with his brother, Mr. RAYMOND GOFF, the day manager, to immediately contact the Alexandria FBI Office, should the individual be seen or an automobile be observed.

Mr. GOFF reflected that there are 108 units in this motel, and it is impossible to acquaint himself with each of the guest. He stated that he would remain alert and keep the newspaper photograph available at the front desk should this man reappear.

No further investigation is contemplated at this time in this regard unless receipt of additional information from the Clarendon Motor Hotel Court.

On 4/19/68, the following investigation was conducted at Jarratt, Va., by SA RAYMOND CONNOLLY, JR., AND SA GORDON G. ROEPKE:

Rev. JOHN QUINCY ADAMS MARTIN, Rt. 1, Box 204, Jarratt, Va., (US 301 1 mile south of Jarratt), at his request was interviewed at his residence

MARTIN stated that at approximately 12:30 to 1 in the afternoon of 4/13/68, he saw what appeared to be a white male individual walking north of US 301. This individual was wearing a blue suit, dressed well and a light colored felt hat. MARTIN stated that at the time he did not think any thing of this individual but after watching the news for four or five days, he finally saw the picture of ERIC STARVO GALT on TV and thought this individual might possibly be the individual who has been accused of assassinating Rev. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR

MARTIN stated that he was about 100 yards away from this individual and did not see his face other than a sideview.

It is to be noted that Rev. MARTIN is 69 years of age, and wears extremely thick glasses. It was noted when photograph of GALT was exhibited to him, that he had difficulty making it out. MARTIN stated also that on that same day, NORMAN SCOTT, who resides in Jarratt, had seen the same individual in Greens-ville County, Va., on Rt. 301.

NORMAN SCOTT, Rt. 1, Box 267, Jarratt, Va., was interviewed and he advised that the individual that he had seen was a shabbily dressed white individual. He could give no further descriptive data but stated that it was about 9:30 A.M. on Monday, 4/15/68, that he had seen the individual in question.



on 4/24/68, Deputy Sheriff GORDON I. JOHNSON, Orange County SO, Orange, Va., advised he had arrested two subjects, JEAN PAUL RAY and SOLOMON JACKSON BERRY, on that date in Orange County Va., in possession of a 1964 Chevelle Malibu Sports Sedan, bearing North Carolina License CM 3175, which vehicle had been reported stolen 4/23/68 from Charlotte, N. C. Recovered in the vehicle was a .38 caliber, Detective Special, Colt revolver, Serial No. 870460, in black-leather, sheep-lined case. Deputy Sheriff JOHNSON advised that in interview of RAY, he admitted ownership of the gun, stating he had purchased it legitimately and, further, that he had spent time in the Missouri State Penitentiary system.

RAY, in interview by Bureau Agent at Orange County, Va., concerning the ITSMV of the above-described vehicle, admitted his true identity as LESLIE MARSHALL HUDSON, a white male, born St. Louis, Missouri, on 2/21/43. HUDSON advised he had, in fact, served time in the Missouri State Penitentiary system, having originally been incarcerated as a juvenile delinquent on 8/15/56 at the Booneville, Mo., Training School and had susequently been transferred to the Algon Reformatory at Jefferson City, Mo., at which Reformatory he was subsequently convicted of and sentenced to four years for assault on a prison guard and two years for an escape and was transferred to the Missouri State Penitentiary, from which

he was discharged in July, 1964.

HUDSON advised that after his discharge from the Missouri State Penitentiary, he had gone to Arlington, Va., where he had joined the American Nazi Party and had lived and worked with them until approximately February, 1965, at which time he went to Georgia, where he was arrested on a car-theft charge at Columbus, Ga., and committed to the State Penitentiary at Reidsville, Ga., on local charges, from which he was discharged on 7/29/66.

HUDSON claimed that he purchased the gun legitimately at Reno, Nevada, during December, 1967, but declined to furnish specific itinerary prior to his arrest at Orange County, Va., by Orange County SO, except to state that he had traveled extensively throughout the entire United States and had been in Charlotte, N. C., on the night of Monday, 4/22/68.

HUDSON was eliminated from fingerprints in a comparison with the I. O. #41821, JAMES EARL RAY.

HUDSON, during interview by Bureau Agent, stated that he believed he knew RAY by sight as a fellow-inmate in the Missouri State Penitentiary system, but denied any personal acquaintanceship with him.

An NCIC check has been made on the .38 caliber Colt revolver recovered in the vehicle; however, results have not as yet been received.

HUDSON has been charged in a detainer filed by the Alamance County SO, Graham, N. C., on a breaking and entering charge on the night of 4/23/68 while en route from Charlotte, N. C., to Orange, Va., in possession of the stolen vehicle. In addition, on 4/25/68, a complaint was filed with the U. S. Commissioner, Richmond, Va., charging HUDSON with violation of Title 18, Section 2312, USC, and detainer being filed. HUDSON has refused to waive extradition to North Carolina on the B & E charge.

HUDSON claims use of the alias JEAN PAUL RAY for approximately a two-year period in order to avoid identification because of his previous connection under his true name of HUDSON with the American Nazi Party at Arlington, Va.



The following is to confirm receipt of information telephonically from Chief of Police R.E. ELLISON, Colonial Heights, Va. PD, by the writer, on 4/26/68 at 9:45AM. This information was immediately relayed by WATS to Supervisor TROW:

Chief ELLISON advised that an FARL DAVIS.W,M, age 45, up until a few months ago had been employed in the Colonial Heights area as a Motor-grader operator on construction jobs. DAVIS lives at Box 265, Route 1, Wilson, N.C. (Tel. #234-5967) On 4/24/68, DAVIS telephonically contacted Dispatcher Theodore Rence, Colonial Heights PD and told Rence to tell Chief ELLISON to come to Wilson, N.C. and take him into custody as he had killed Dr. Martin LUther King. DAVIS again called on the early evening of 4/25/68 and again asked the dispatcher to advise Chief ELLISON to come to Wilson, N.C. so that he could give himself up to him for killing Dr. King.

Chief ELLISON advised that he had hesitated to affivise the FBI of this information at first because DAVIS is known to him to be addicted to alchahol.
