The following investigation was conducted by SAs WARREN P. DELP and JOHN WILLIAM DAVIS: on 5/28/68:

Mr. JESSIE W. MC BRIDE. Owner, 12 W. Main St., Richmond, Va., advised that he had recently seen several photographs of JAMES FARL RAY in Newsweek magazine and that two of these photographs very much resembled an individual he had recently seen in his restaurent. The photographs which MC BRIDE thought resembled this individual were both taken in approximately 1959. MC BRIDE examined a photograph of RAY taken in Jan. or Feb., 1968 and stated this did not resemble the individual whom he had referred to as having been in his restaurent.

HUBERT SMITH, Manager, Milner Hotel, 10 W. Main St., Richmond, examined the most current photograph of RAY as well as the photographs which had been in Newsweek Magazine and stated that none of these photographs were at all familiar to him.

LLOYD WILLIAMS, Clerk Dispatcher, Employers Overload Co., 15 W. Main St., Richmond, examined the most recent photograph of JAMES EARL RAY as well as the photographs of RAY which appeared in Newsweek Magazine and stated he was sure he had never seen this individual before.






