At 11:47 PM this date an individual who identified himself as MEL DAVIS called this office from the Greyhound Bus Station. DAVIS said that he knew who killed Martin Luther King. DAVIS said that he did not want to talk over the phone. DAVIS did say that "somebody from Los Angeles killed him".

DAVIS then terminated the call. From the sound of DAVIS voice he appeared to be a Negro and did not sound intoxicated.

SAC COLE was advised and upon his instructions SA KEMMY and SA MOODY were advised.'

"I ask every citizen to stay away from violence," Mr. Johnson urged. He added that every American of good will should join him in praying for understanding.

We must solemnly hope that the President's urging is heeded by all.

AL KUETNER, Senior Editor Pace Magazine, 833 S. Flower St., Los Angeles, California, 4/5/68, telephonically contacted SA THOMAS W. CRAWFORD, San Antonio Office, from Chicago, Illinois, where he was on a writing assignment.

Mr. KUETNER for ten years or more Chief of the Atlanta, Georgia, UPI Bureau and thereby well acquainted with MARTIN LUTHER KING's career, advised that many of the highlights or crises of KING's life seemed to coincide with critical points in proceedings in the United Nations, or in the general area of International tensions where the dark-skinned world was in contest with the western or white world in which the United States holds pre-eminence.

Mr. KUETNER cited the fact that at the point when President JOHNSON was to embark for Hawaii with predictable raising the USA's image, KING was murdered and the President detained due to domestic turmoil.

Mr. KUETNER stated, along these lines, that when MEDGAR EVERS, closely allied in KING's endeavors, was murdered, the United States was involved in critical debate in the U.N. over issues in Africa, Asia or both, lands

predominantly non white.

The crisis in Birmingham coincided with a serious debate in the U.N. between the white and non-white powers, and so on.

Mr. KUETNER stated that, in the limited time permitted over long-distance telephone, he was unable to develop the above suggested thesis. He said he felt that such thesis might have some bearing in development of the suspect or suspects in this case.

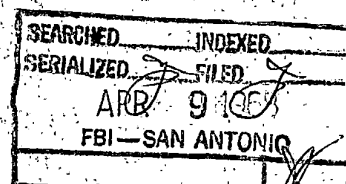

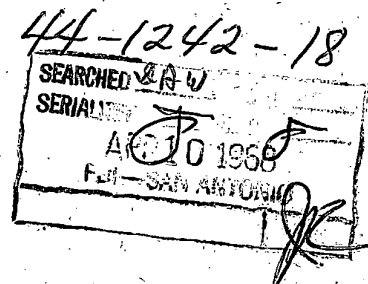

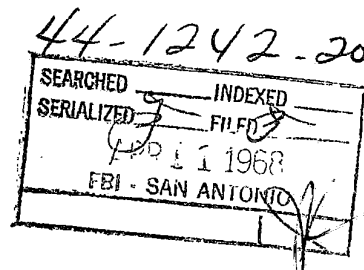
