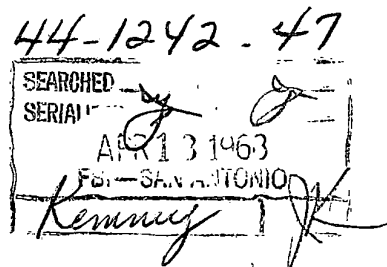

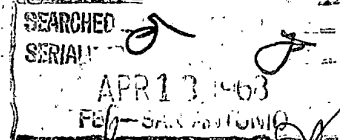

FRANCES GONZALEZ, Records Clerk, Harlingen, Texas, PD made available accident report #18351 which reflects that a 1968 Rambler sedan owned by FRANCISCO LOYA, 509 W. ~~WILKIE~~ Filmore St., Harlingen, was parked in a private drive on B St. near the intersection with W. Harrison St., with about three feet of the rear sticking out in the street. At about 7:11 PM, 3/31/68, a car made a left turn at a high rate of speed from W. Harrison onto B St., skidded about six feet and clipped the rear end of LOYA's car, damaging the bumper, trunk and rear fenders. This car did not stop and no description was obtained by the investigating officer. Two witnesses in two cars travelling in the opposite direction to the violator were listed as DOUG HANSEN, Rt. 1, Box 352, San Benito, Texas, and RAMIRO PESINA, 1218 Basin Drive, Harlingen, Texas.

Lt. ABEL LOZANO, FBI NA, Harlingen PD, advised no additional information was ever developed or reported to that Dept.

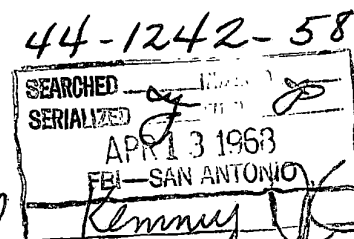

On 4/10/68 PAUL LEONARD, owner of the Sea Ranch Motel on S. Padre Island, Texas, advised that on the past Saturday night he went by the home of BILL HUCKABY, Missouri carpenter doing work for him, re additional work desired. A drinking party was in progress, and he was introduced to persons present including a man who had just driven in from Tennessee. He mentioned "it must be a mess back there", and the Tennessee man replied "it's only the beginning; if RAY BROWN or SPURLEY CARMICHAEL show up there, they wont last 15 minutes", and further stated it was a woman rather than a man who killed KING. On Tuesday, 4/9/68, this same Tennessee man came to do the work requested by LEONARD. That evening LEONARD watched the Walter Cronkite TV newscast and saw the artist's sketch of the murder suspect who was believed driving a white car, and he had a feeling he had seen this individual. On Wednesday morning he suddenly realized the Tennessee man was a "dead ringer" for the artist's sketch. He recalled the man was referred to as DAVE.

DAVID DEWITT GREER, aka "Dave", located at the waterfront residence of HUCKABY in Port Isabel, Texas, advised as follows:

He has been residing for some time at Rt. 7, Sparta, Tenn., property owned by J. W. GERTLA who manages the Travelodge Motel at Roanoke, Va., as caretaker working on the side as carpenter, and he was there during March, 1968, and to 4/5/68. On the latter date he boarded the Greyhound bus at 12:30 PM at Crossville, Tenn., being taken to the bus by SONNIE BROWN LEWIS, JR., Rt. 4, Box 242A, Crossville, Tenn.; and he arrived at Memphis, Tenn., at 9:55 PM where his wife had come, by prearrangement, from Little Rock. They then drove to Port Isabel, Texas, leaving Memphis immediately. He has

Simple Ceremony Honors Dr. King

About 30 persons attended a brief and simple wreath-laying ceremony at the Alamo Tuesday afternoon in memory of Dr. Martin Luther King, whose funeral was held just hours before in Atlanta.

A red ribbon across the wreath bore the inscription "I Have Seen the Mountain Top," a statement from one of the slain Negro leader's last speeches.

The ceremonies were sponsored by the Youth Council of the local chapter of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People. Mrs. Augusta Collins, adult adviser of the group, directed the event.

A car and a station wagon, each carrying about 15 people, drove from the intersection of Avenue E and Third Street to the front of the Alamo, a distance of some three blocks, where they were joined by others.

Rev. L. C. Glasco, first vice president of the NAACP branch, delivered brief remarks lauding the dead Dr. King and stating he had died "so all men could be free."

S. L. Deckard, president, read an open letter to Mrs. King. "He (Dr. King) had the compassion and love for all mankind which mark the true believers in non-violence," the letter said in part.

Before ending, the mourners joined hands and sang "We Shall Overcome." The wreath was carried to its place by Peggy Smith and Christine Jackson, both members of the Youth Council.

The 10-minute ceremony ended about 5:45 p.m. About 12 city policemen were at the Alamo and along the "motorcade" route.

Mrs. Collins said a musical tribute to Dr. King will be presented at 3:30 p.m. Sunday at Friendship Baptist Church. It will consist of solo and choral singing and instrumental music.
