At approximately 3:55 PM, 4/9/68, a lady who identified herself as Mrs. MABLE BLAIR SLACK, residence 3506 Tom Green St., Austin, Texas, telephonically informed as follows:

She has been employed as a PBX operator at the Sheraton-Crest Hotel, Austin, Texas. An individual named JOHN WILLARD has registered in that hotel on at least two occasions. One registration card reflects that JOHN WILLARD is from Charleston, South Carolina, and that he is a Revlon representative. He was at the hotel approximately two months ago. While at the hotel he received "strange" telephone calls.

Mrs. SLACK was apprehensive about furnishing the information about WILLARD to a local Agent and wanted to know if she could trust them. She was informed she could trust any FBI Agent. She stated that most of the people in that area are racists and that they laugh at her for taking up for President JOHNSON.

Among her comments is the fact that while WILLARD was in the hotel, Mrs. SLACK's recollection is to the effect that he received telephone calls from Memphis.

Before I could ask additional questions, she stated she could not afford a telephone call. I informed her an Agent from the San Antonio Office would get in touch with her.

This will record that at 6:10 P. M., 4/11/68, Inspector SULLIVAN, in charge of captioned investigation at Memphis, Tennessee, called me to advise that the 1966 Ford Mustang, reportedly owned by suspect GALT, had been located in Atlanta. This car, according to SULLIVAN, bears two Tourista stickers dated October, 1967, showing folio # H294486, and also indicating that the car had entered Mexico at Nuevo Laredo, Tamps.

Mr. SULLIVAN desired to know what kind of identification GALT used and requested that we obtain all the information available showing his destination, purpose, point of egress, etc.

I relayed the above information to SA SLIGHT at Laredo who has checked with the Nuevo Laredo entry point and has determined that GALT entered Mexico October 7, 1967, under his established name. He was driving a 1966 Ford Mustang, two door, 8 cylinder, with VIN 6T070190647, and Alabama plates 138993. He was issued Tourist Card FM57475449, and showed Birmingham address of 2608 Hichland. His date of birth was indicated as _______ The record reflected he was single, that he was employed in Birmingham and that his final destination was Mexico City.

Today I relayed the above information to Inspector SULLIVAN and informed him I would get in touch with Legat, Mexico City, to determine what additional data might be developed based on this information.

I thereafter called Assistant Legat JOHN FOARD, furnished him this information and told him to make any checks possible to obtain additional data indicating GALT visited in Mexico City. He said he would do this and would advise me or the Memphis office. 44-1242-71

On 4/15/68, BISMARK BELL, 314 North Celorado, San Antonio, Texas, telephonically contacted the San Antonio Office with the following information:

BELL explained on Saturday evening, 4/6/68, at approximately 7:00 p.m., he had been in the Depot Liquor Store located at the corner of Medina and Commerce Streets, San Antonio, when an unidentified Latin American male had spoken to him stating he, the unknown male, thought the assassination of Dr. KING was a shame. BELL stated he did not want to talk with the unknown man and stated he also thought the killing was a shame and left the store.

BELL stated he had no idea who the man was or why the above remark had been made. BELL stated he had been thinking about the situation and due to the publicity of the search for the killer, he had decided to report the foregoing to this Office.

BELL described the unknown man as a Latin American male, 35-40 years of age, 175 pounds, black hair and dark eyes. The man spoke excellent english according to BELL, wore dark trousers, dark glasses and a crucifix.





On 4/15/68, MABLE CLAIR SLACK, 3506 Tom Green St., Austin, Texas, advised SA JAMES E. FARMER as follows.

She is a PBX operator at the Sheraton-Crest Inn, a motor hotel at 1st and Congress Avenue, Austin, Texas.

Having read a newspaper account that a JOHN WILLARD was a suspect in the MARTIN LUTHER KING murder at Memphis, Tenn., on 4/4/68, she recalled that a person by the same name had resided at the Crest on two different occasions during the recent past.

She had observed the registration cards for WILLARD, which indicated he was a representative for the Revlon Co., that his home was in Charleston, S.C. She had not observed WILLARD, but only recalled that she had received many suspicious calls some of which she thought may have come from Memphis, Tenn. She could not recall the substance of the calls and she was unable to explain why the calls were suspicious to her.

She indicated that members of her family thought she was crazy as she was suspicious of so many people. She is of the opinion that the Crest is a meeting place for racists of all types, including the Minutemen, Ku Klux Klan, Birchers, and the like.

In addition to the above information, Mrs. SLACK also indicated that she would like to furnish information regarding numerous other people she was suspicious of as being racists. While making the telephone appointment with Mrs. SLACK, she reported that a suspicious truck was parked across the street from her residence. She indicated that the truck had advertising on it which reflected it was a diaper service truck, but she was very suspicious of the occupants as the truck had been seen in the area on other occasions.

On 4/15/68, ALBERT SHERWOOD, Assistant Manager, Sheraton-Crest Inn, Austin, Texas, advised from records as follows.

JOHN WILLARD, 4019 Ridgecrest Avenue, Charlotte, N.C., representing Revlon, Inc., 666 5th Avenue, New York City, was registered (card #53352) in room 426 for the night of 11/26-27/67 and (card #54168) in room 304 for two nights 1/6-8/68. The records failed to show any record of long distance calls, and he noted that local calls are dialed direct and therefore the phone numbers are not recorded.

It would appear that Mrs. SLACK, who is a person of about sixty years, is mentally disturbed. In view of information furnished by her, a lead is not being set forth to eliminate the person JOHN WILLARD who stayed at the Crest Inn on the two occasions. Any action deemed advisable is being left to the discretion of the 00 in this matter.
