The following investigation was conducted by SA GEORGE GEDDIS, III, on May 1, 1968, at Seguin, Texas:

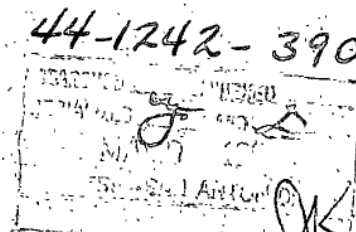
Deputy Sheriff A. J. STOLL, Guadalupe County SO, advised that he has known JACK Q. HARBORT for three or four years. He said HARBORT is definitely not identical with the subject of Wanted Flyer 442-A, JAMES EARL RAY. He advised that HARBORT works as a truck driver for Coast Manufacturing Company on King Street.

Mr. LAUD L. WALTER, Plant Manager, Coast Manufacturing Company, Box 950, N. King Street, Seguin, Texas, furnished the following information from personal knowledge and company records:

He said HARBORT is not identical with the subject of Wanted Flyer 442-A, JAMES EARL RAY. JACK Q. HARBORT has worked for his company since 12/10/62. He is presently employed as a truck driver making alternate runs to Ohio and California. In 1965 his description was hair dark, eyes brown, height 5'11", weight 211 pounds, DOB [REDACTED] Social Security Number [REDACTED]. Present address 115 Lake Placid, Seguin. Military Service: U. S. Marine Corps, from 12/15/53 through 12/25/55. School attendance: Through 9th grade ending at Seguin High School.

In view of the above information, no further action is being taken at this time.

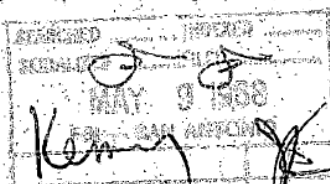

Justice of the Peace G. A. RUST is the owner of Rust Truck Lines. GEORGE RUST on 5/2/68 advised that his truck line operates in the Sanderson, Texas area. it reads: "Be sure & put that letter you receive tomorrow in the mail box- Listen to nobody or call the F.B.I. office if anybody tells you not to." Card bore a 10¢ airmail stamp, cancelled.

Mrs. INGRAM at same time furnished an opened brown manilla, large size envelope, also bearing p.m., May 2, 1968, postmark and addressed to MAXINE INGRAM, which she identified as coming also from ROBERT P. ANDERSON, her former employer.

Inside this manilla envelope was a white legal-size envelope addressed: "Mrs. DEMPES, 8251 Burley, Chicago, Illinois 60617". The second letter in name DEMPES is not clearly legible.

None of the above-described card or envelopes bears ANDERSON's name or return address.

Retel 5/1/68 reflects ANDERSON on interview by Bureau Agents in recent past acknowledged writing letter to SAC JOHN P. MULL, JR., Phoenix Division: "Either JOHN C. MULL JR. kills himself or certainly I will".

ANDERSON also came to notice of Chicago, Illinois, Police in the past, having shot and injured a woman at a social gathering.

Inasmuch as ANDERSON, aka, RUSSELL JOHNSTONE, appears

Re El Paso ~~letter~~ to Director 4/30/68 indicating call from Van Horn, Texas to 915-345-2517 in Sanderson, Texas. Telephone directory for Sanderson indicated this to be the listing for Mrs. J.R. Blackwelder, 208 W. Hackberry, Sanderson. Sheriff Cooksey advised on 5/7/68 that Mrs. BLACKWELDER is a widow, about 65 years of age who is employed as a baby-sitter by him as his wife is employed. Sheriff Cooksey advised that he asked Mrs. Blackwelder about receiving a telephone call from Van Horn on 12/15/68 and she advised him that she recalls this call as it came from a Mr. Hill who called her to inquire about his children with whom she was baby sitting at that time.

Re ~~4/11/68~~ Dallas teletype to Director and San Antonio 5/1/68, listing the following calls from Sanderson, Texas to Brackettville and Del Rio, Texas:

563-2433 (Brackettville)-this phone listed to Francisco Parras, Brackettville. PARRAS is employee at Laughlin AFB, Del Rio and advised

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on 5/6/68 that he recalls getting a telephone call on he believes 12/17/68 from his wife and brother-in-law who were in the Sanderson area and were delayed returning to Brackettville due to bad weather.

775-3185 (Del Rio) - Telephone listed to A.R. Benitez, clerk at Ross Drug Store, Del Rio. On 5/6/68 Mr. BENITEZ advised that he recalls that on or about 12/17/68 he received a telephone call from Sanderson at the above number (775-3185) from his son who was travelling in that area and had run out of gas for his automobile.

775-2501 (Del Rio) - Listing for Milo V. Cadena, 301 Pauline Dr., Del Rio - Mr. Cadena advised on 5/6/68 that he does not recall receiving any calls from the Sanderson area in the period 12/15-17/68. Mr. Cadena checked with his wife and she advised that she could recall no long distance calls from Sanderson in that period. It is noted that CADENA is the owner of Felicios Restaurant, a large restaurant in Del Rio, and that he has considerable ranching interest in the Del Rio-Sanderson area.

775-2617 (Del Rio) (Serial 44-1242-293) listed to C.R. Arroyos, Del Rio. Mr. Arroyos interviewed 5/8/68. He indicated he was long time employee of Texas Highway Dept. at Del Rio. Mr. Arroyos did not recall receiving long distance call from Marfa, Texas on 12/16/68 but indicated he has relatives in that area of Texas who sometime call him.

The following negative information concerning telephone calls made from pay phone booths along Route 90 in the towns of Waelder, Harwood, and Kingsbury was developed by SA GEORGE GEDDIS III:

On 5/2/68, Mrs. HENRIETTA WESCH of the Guadalupe Valley Telephone Co-Op, at Smithson's Valley, Texas, advised that her company covers the towns of Kingsbury and Harwood, Texas. She indicated she would check on all pay phones located along Highway 90 at or near Kingsbury and Harwood.

On 5/2/68, contact was attempted but, apparently because of the telephone strike, was not effected at the General Telephone Co. at Bryan, Texas, which covers the town of Waelder, Texas.

On 5/3/68, Mrs. WESCH advised that no pay phones were located at or around the town of Harwood, and only two pay phones were located in Kingsbury. She said that a call was made from one of these phones located at the Hurt Bros. Garage in Kingsbury on 12/16/67, to Luling, Texas (875-2476).

On 5/6/68, that number was contacted and a Mr. EDGAR McDONALD of the C-S Lease Service indicated that he probably had made that call from his residence at Kingsbury on that particular date. He indicated no knowledge of the possible suspect JAMES EARL RAY under his true name or aliases.

Mrs. WESCH further advised that the other telephone call was made from the Blue Bird Inn at Kingsbury to Saturn, Texas (495-3458) to a person named WILLIAMS.

He indicated that all of the records relating to pay telephone booths are destroyed after 90 days and it would have been impossible to determine whether any long distance calls were made from the town of Waelder.

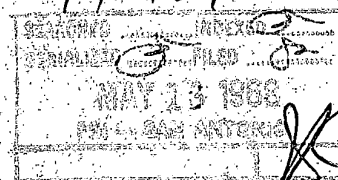

In connection with the captioned case there has been speculation that James Earl Ray concocted the alias of Eric Starvo Galt by combining the names of characters from books by Ian Fleming and from a book "Atlas Shrugged" by Ayn Rand. This speculation is based on the fact that in the James Bond books by Ian Fleming there is a character named Ernst Stavro Blofield and in "Atlas Shrugged" there is a character named John Galt, as well as one named Eric Starnes. Ernst Stavro Blofield is a formidable person, John Galt is a "social drop out" and Eric Starnes is described in the book as a "whiner" from a low-class family.

In view of the above and in order that Agents handling this investigation can be alert to the possibility of Ray's utilizing an alias based on characters in Fleming's books, there is set out as an attachment to this airtel a list of various characters in those books for your assistance.

A search of City Directories and telephone books did not disclose any contractor by the name of McCaffrey.

On 5/9/68 SA GEORGE KEEFER interviewed the following persons at the Bamboo Hut, 6812 San Pedro, San Antonio:

BOB GUERRA, owner

ANN ROSS, bartender

Miss ROSS advised that she did not see anyone sitting at the bar at the Bamboo Hut on the night of 5/4/68 who resembled the photograph of JAMES EARL RAY or in any way resembled the description of the individual in retel.

BOB GUERRA advised that he was on duty on the night of 5/4/68 waiting on tables situated in a different portion of the establishment from that occupied by the bar. He said that he remembered four women who sat at a table and who appeared to be bowlers attending a Women's Bowling Congress Convention currently being held in San Antonio. He said that during the evening an individual described as in retel did approach these women and try to become better acquainted with them. He said it was his observation that they did not want to have anything to do with him and tried to discourage conversation but that he was persistent. GUERRA said he had never seen this man before and that the individual has not been in the Bamboo Hut since 5/4/68. After seeing the photograph of JAMES EARL RAY on W.F. # 442A GUERRA stated that he is of the opinion that the man above referred to is not identical with RAY. He said that the patron of 5/4/68 was about 5'11" tall, weighed about 150 pounds, and had a very slender build. He said that the man was in his 40's, had long dark hair, was well-dressed but looked dirty. He said he did not see any scars or marks on this man and did not note any peculiarity with reference to an ear. He said the man had a very narrow face with a long pointed chin and was drinking whiskey from a bottle he had brought with him. He said he did not see the cigarette lighter described in retel and did not hear the name BOB SHILLINGS. He stated that he would call the FBI if this individual ever appeared again at the Bamboo Hut.

On 5/9/68, the photographs of SMITH were displayed to ANGEL STICKELBAULT, his wife, and his mother. Each indicated that the photo was not that of the man whom they identified on the bus to Mexico on 4/6/68 as JAMES EARL RAY. They advised that the photo of SMITH was that of a man much younger whose hair was too long and face was too elongated, rather than roundish as is that of RAY.

STICKELBAULT and his family reiterated that the Unsub on the bus looked enough like RAY to be either him or a "twin".

For information Dallas, reairtel advised as follows.

On 5/2/68, Mrs. A. M. WITTNE, 901 Dabney, Corpus Christi, Texas, advised as follows.

She was formerly employed by Liberty Mutual Insurance Company, 4th Floor, Milam Building, San Antonio, Texas. This company had in its office an album of professional insurance claimants, which she believes was compiled and maintained by Southwest Index Bureau. Recently upon seeing newspaper and television photographs of subject, it seemed to her she had observed a photograph in the album of professional insurance claimants at the Liberty Mutual Insurance Company office which was that of subject, or someone who looked very similar to him. Further, she thought possibly the name JAMES EARL RAY was included in the above index and album.

On 5/8/68, Mr. J. EDGAR BOWDEN, Claims Manager, Liberty Mutual Insurance Company, Room 411 Milam Building, San Antonio, Texas, advised SA DEAN N. LLOYD that review of indices for JAMES EARL RAY and known aliases was negative. BOWDEN suggested that the Fraud and Arson Bureau and the Southwest Index Bureau, both located in Dallas, be contacted inasmuch as they maintain a national index of professional claimants.

AT DALLAS, TEXAS. Will locate and interview appropriate officials of Southwest Index Bureau and Fraud and Arson Bureau to determine if JAMES EARL RAY is known to them under true name, known aliases, or known description.

ARMED AND DANGEROUS.

(B) WHITE MILITANT GROUPS - RACIAL MATTERS (ORGANIZATION) -- In view of increasing militancy in the racial field, neighborhood groups whose members are of the white race, have been springing up throughout the United States. Some of these groups appear to be militant in nature and some urge the white man to arm himself as a means of protection against racial violence. Some of these groups are known to sponsor demonstrations against integration and against the bussing of Negro students to white schools. Others appear to advocate more violent methods of opposition to integration. The appearance of these groups is noted mostly in the white ghetto areas of the large cities which border on minority group living areas.

In order to fulfill our responsibilities in the racial intelligence field we must be cognizant of the groups and their aims and purposes. Upon receipt of information as to the formation or existence of such a group, a preliminary investigation should be immediately initiated to determine the aims and purposes of the organization, its leaders, approximate membership, as well as any pertinent background data which will assist in determining the militancy of the group.

From information presently available, it appears that many of these organizations have been founded on principles of fear rather than hate and as such, they cannot be classified as hate groups. Your investigations should, therefore, be discreet and most circumspect. You should limit your inquiries to a review of Bureau files, contacts with Bureau informants, and established sources, and the use of public source information.

Upon completion of your investigations, a communication in form suitable for dissemination should be forwarded to the Bureau together with a recommendation as to whether additional investigation is warranted under Section 122A of the Manual of Instructions as it pertains to the investigation of Klan and white hate groups.

In addition to the above, I wish to point out to you the possibility of reactions by the Klan, white hate groups, and residents of white ghetto areas to the recent wave of racial disorders resulting from the assassination of Martin Luther King, Jr. You should remain alert to this possibility. Informant coverage of the Klan, white hate groups, and white ghetto areas must be intensified so that plans of retaliation or overt action are known to the Bureau prior to their taking place.
