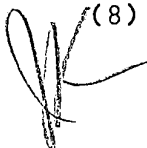

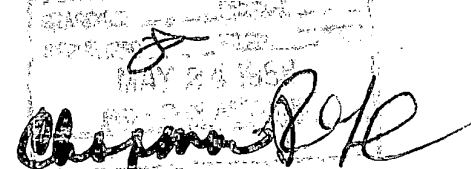

The following investigation was conducted by SA GEORGE F. BULDAIN on 5/27/68. Except as noted below, all telephone numbers assigned to the subscribers set forth below were assigned to the subscribers in December, 1967. None of the persons interviewed were familiar with the photos of JAMES EARL RAY, aka., and all advised RAY is unknown to them.

1. 225-2545 - Assigned to City Public Service Board, 145 Navarro. Mrs. GLENDA EILAND, Accounts Information Office, CPSB, advised this telephone number is one four "trunk line" numbers assigned to CPSB in February, 1968, and was not assigned to CPSB in December, 1967. Mrs. LOTTIE MITCHELL, Security Supervisor's Office, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (Protect) advised telephone company records would only reflect when this number was assigned to CPSB, and would not reflect who the previous subscriber would be. This number is not reflected in the 1967 Cole's Criss-Cross Directory.

2. 225-6341 - Assigned to Davila Produce Co., 1500 So. Zazaarmora St. Mr. BENNIE DAVILA, President, Davila Produce Company, advised this phone number is for a telephone in his office. He normally receives all incoming calls to this number, and he is unable to recall what calls he received on 12/15/67.

3. 225-7411 - Assigned to the San Antonio News-Express Office, 3rd & Ave E. Mrs. GLORIA SIMPSON, Chief Switchboard Operator at this number, advised that hundreds of calls are received daily at this number, which is also the calling number for Channel 5 KENS TV in San Antonio, and that an incoming call on 12/15/67 could have been placed to anyone employed with the San Antonio Express or News, or with Channel 5 TV station.

4. 226-6136 - Assigned to Continental Trailways, 301 Broadway. Mr. H. F. LEHRER, Terminal Manager, Continental Trailways, advised this is one of five rotary numbers assigned to Continental Trailways. Hundreds of calls are received each day, and it would be impossible to say to whom the call on 12/17/68 was placed. Since this was shortly before the Christmas holidays, it could have been anyone calling for bus schedule information, tour information, or baggage and express information. At that time Continental Trailways was moving a lot of service men on furlough, and a lot of service men will utilize a pay phone to call in to the bus station to obtain information.

SUTTON, Switchboard Operator, Frito Lay Inc., advised Frito Lay has two salesmen who regularly call in every day, one from Highway 90E and one from Hwy. 90W. She normally receives all incoming calls, and she always obtains the name of every person who calls. There are normally five people in the Office every day to whom calls could be made. In a recent survey made on incoming calls it was determined that the Office receives an average of 120 calls per day. The name & photos of JAMES EARL RAY are not familiar to her.

6. 226-7311. - Assigned to Foremost Dairies, 102 E. Josephine. Mr. W. E. WATERS, District Manager, Foremost Dairies, advised there are 110 employees with Foremost Dairies in San Antonio, and it would be impossible to determine who received a particular call to this phone number on 12/15/68. Foremost has a distributor in Laredo, one in Uvalde, and several supervisors who are continually calling in, and truck drivers working for these distributors, if they need to contact Foremost Dairies on some matter, frequently call into the San Antonio Office from along Highway 90. WATERS advised that recently his office was contacted by an FBI Agent concerning the murder of MARTIN LUTHER KING in connection with a lead involving a credit card allegedly used by JAMES EARL RAY. At that time photos of RAY were shown to the various employees available in the office with negative results.

7. 226-7353 - Assigned to Cavender General Oldsmobile, 801 Broadway. Miss JOAN KRYDA, Relief Switchboard Operator, Cavender General Oldsmobile, advised this is a switchboard number for the firm, which employes about 100 people within its various departments. 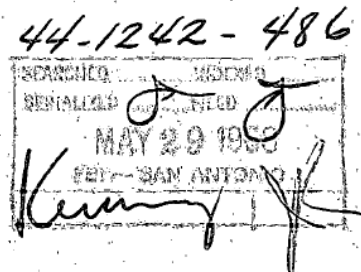

On 5/27/68, EDUARDO JOSE MOLINA, Avenida Colon 505C, Merida, Yucatan, Republic of Mexico, contacted SRA CLAY ZACHRY, JR., at Brownsville, Texas. He said that he had mentioned the subject he wanted to discuss with Inspector L.M. HATTENBACH of INS in Brownsville and that HATTENBACH had referred him to SA ZACHRY.

MOLINA said that on the Isla Mujeres, an island off the Gulf Coast of the Yucatan Peninsula and in the Territory of Quintana Roo and about a 20-minute flight from Merida, there is a hotel called the Sadzil Ha. This is a first-class hotel owned and operated by a man named LIMA. MOLINA said that LIMA is not honest or reliable and should not be trusted for a contact by the FBI or anyone representing the FBI. About four days prior to 5/27/68, MOLINA said that LIMA's son, first name unknown, was heard to say that JAMES EARL RAY is working in the kitchen of the Sadzil Ha Hotel on the Isla Mujeres.

The following information regarding the source, MOLINA, was obtained by SA ZACHRY from observation and interview. He is a very dignified and well-dressed Mexican male who remarked that he is 65 years old. He speaks excellent

English with a slight Spanish accent and states that he went to school in England when very young and has his degree from Boston College in Boston. He is bald with some gray hair at the temples, has brown eyes, light complexion, is about 5'8" tall and slender in build. He claims to own the property at 54 Jacaranda Street in Brownsville and says that he paid \$30,000 for the dwelling to be used by his daughter whose husband is with Pepsi-Cola in Mexico and was formerly stationed in Matamoros, Tamps. He flew to Brownsville, from Mexico City via Aeronaves from Mexico to Matamoros. He owns a 1966 Pontiac GTO with 1967 Texas license DIPL0-2 that is being driven from Merida to Brownsville by one of his children. MOLINA said that he is staying at the Ft. Brown Motor Hotel but thinks that he will move to the Valley Inn and Country Club and expects to be in Brownsville four or five days. He stated that he is a retired business man and made his money in hemp and that he has been active in politics in Yucatan but in PAN rather than the official party PRI.

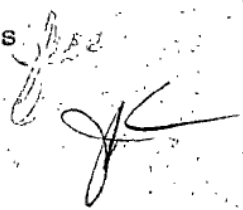
