In response to the information contained in re memo. the writer contacted the Security Office of the Hemisfair 1968 and therefy obtained the assistance of Capt. JOE NEAVES who in turn gathered a half dozen uniform and plain clothes officers to the vicinity of the Water Show, Hemisfair 1968. Capt.NEAVES covered both exits of the Water Show on a presumption that the individual believed to be JAMES EARL RAY was in the stands watching the Water Show.

Writer meanwhile discreetly contacted AL BURNS, the house manager, in an effort to reach DICK ROWE the general manager of the water show.

ROWE was more or less immediately encountered driving to the Water Show on a motor scooter and stated that he had attempted to locate again the individual resembling JAMES EARL RAY whom he had seen only hurriedly and with a glimpse crossing a bridge near the Water Show. ROWE said he had been unsuccessful but he described this individual as set forth in re memo.

Lt. JIM POPEr of the Civilian Guard Service at Hemisfair and the writer within a few minutes encountered an individual fitting the above description. He was surveilled to a location within the arena and accosted by the writer supported by Capt. NEAVES with other officers in the immediate vicinity. This individual identified himself with a current Texas Drivers License No. 537677, which bore the following description, which fit the individual on visual inspection;

Mr. MATTHEWS also displayed an Elk Lodge card indicating he was in Pasadena, Texas lodge No. 1832.

Mr. MATTHEWS stated that he had come to San Antonio arfew days previous attending the recently ended Lumbermens Convention at the Hemisfair. He said that he was remaining very briefly in San Antonio awaiting certain trucks to carry off exhibits that had been brought from Houston to the convention. Captain NEAVES concurred with the writer that this individual did not match the description of JAMES EARL RAY in light of the discrepancy in height and color of his hair, as well as the authenticity of MATTHEWS' personal credentials.

This individual indicated that he bore no hard feeling at being so accosted by law enforcement officers and expressed the sense that he knew these things could occur due to reported likenesses.

The following investigation was conducted by SA HAROLD H. CROSSETT:

On April 22, 1968, JUAN AGUILAR, Chief of Immigration, Mexican Immigration Service, Reynosa, Mexico, was furnished the true name and additional aliases of JAMES EARL RAY and was requested to check through his tourist permits issued at that port of entry subsequent to April 1, 1968.

On April 23, 1968, AGUILAR was furnished Wanted Flyers printed in the Spanish language relative to RAY.

AGUILAR stated a review of his tourist permits issued from April 1, 1968 through April 22, 1968, failed to reveal that a permit had been issued for the subject.

On 4/30/68 ALAN DENNISON HALL, 1907 Whitis, Austin, Texas, a visiting lecturer in English at the University of Texas, advised that he had taken the bus from Nuevo Laredo to Mexico City, Mexico, on 4/6/68; that the trip from Nuevo Laredo to Monterrey was during the early morning hours from about 2 to 3AM to about 7AM or so; and that he recalled a stop past Monterrey known as San Luis Potisi, Mexico.

HALL stated that he had taken a bus from San Antonio, Texas, to the Mexican border the afternoon prior to his entry into Mexico, and that it took nearly 2 hours to clean Customs. He stated that during the time he travelled from Nuevo Laredo to Monterrey he slept for the most part, and that when he was not asleep he visited with a fellow traveller, an Englishman, name unknown, who was a visiting student at Rice University, Houston, Texas, (apparently referring to GRAHAM ROBERT SMITH).

HALL advised that he paid little attention to the passengers entering or leaving the bus enroute to Mexico City, Mexico, however, that the photograph and description of JAMES EARL RAY was not familiar to him. He also advised that the descriptive data of the person furnished by the complainant in this matter did not resemble anyone he recalled as being on the bus in question.



On 4/30/68, Mrs. ERNESTINA MONTEAGUDO, 2116 Kennedy Circle, telephone MU 6-1094, McAllen, Texas, was interviewed in the Spanish language. Mrs. MONTEAGUDO, a Mexican female, widow, with six children, advised that she never receives long-distance telephone calls, having very few relatives or friends outside McAllen, Texas. However, she recalled that her brother, PEDRO FLORES, a resident of California, as is his annual custom, spent the Christmas vacation period, December, 1967, with her and her children. He brought with him a Mexican-American girl friend from Uvalde, Texas, during the last visit, and this woman received two or three telephone calls at Mrs. MONTEAGUDO's home from her family in Uvalde, Texas. Mrs. MONTEAGUDO stated she does not recall the exact dates of these calls, but is certain that, if a call was made to her number from Uvalde, Texas, on 12/15/67, it was her brother's girl friend's family calling.

Mrs. MONTEAGUDO stated photographs and the name and aliases of JAMES EARL RAY were completely unfamiliar to her.





Following investigation conducted by SA JOSEPH C. WEBB, JR.:

#### AT D'HANIS, TEXAS:

On 4/30/68 inquiry with local postmaster revealed that Mrs. ALF NESTER, telephone number 512 363-7355, has been confined to a nursing home in Hondo, Texas, for approximately three years.

Mr. CLAYTON NESTER, cattle buyer, son of Mrs. ALF NESTER, who lives at the same nursing home in Hondo, informed telephone number 363-7355 is the number for his ranch at D'Hanis where CARLOS ORTEGA lives who works for him.

NESTER said that ORTEGA has lived in the ranchhouse since August, 1967, and would have lived there on or about 12/15/67.

NESTER said he sometimes uses this telephone when he wants to make telephone calls to other cattle buyers and does not want anyone to know where he called from.

NESTER said he has never received any telephone call at this number on or about 12/15/67. He could not identify the WF on JAMES EAR RAY.

On 4/30/68 Mrs. CARLOS ORTEGA and her daughter Mrs. JUAN SALINAS, advised they have lived at the Nester ranch since August, 1967, and were living there on or about 12/15/67. Neither of these persons could identify the WF of JAMES EARL RAY or knew anyone using that name or any of the aliases.

ORTEGA and SALINAS both denied receiving any station to station telephone call from Uvalde, Texas, 12/15/67. They said there was no one at their house on 12/15/67 who received such a telephone call, and knew no one who might have called them from Uvalde from a paybooth.

NESTER pointed out the ORTEGA family is a good Latin-American family and that none of them has ever been in any trouble. He said however they have lots of relatives in Uvalde and knows they call back and form many times. He said he feels certain they are "lying"/about bot knowand bout the telephone call, and are afraid they might get someone in trouble by admitting to it.

On April 30, 1968 BERNABE ESCAMILLA, 214 West 6th, Elsa, Texas, advised he hastelephone number 262-2298 (AM2-2298).

MR. ESCAMILLA, who speaks very little English, stated he has received no telephone calls from Uvalde, Texas to his knowledge, however, in about December, 1967 he received a call from someone who wanted him to get in touch with EUSEBIO TORRES of Elsa and inform TORRES that some of his relatives had been involved in an automobile accident near San Antonio, Texas. He said he had been unable to locate TORRES, who was out of town, and when he received another call a couple of hours later he so informed the caller.

ESCAMILLA stated he recalls the caller was a man but does not recall his name and is under the impression that the call originated in Laredo, Texas but is not positive about this and it could possibly have been from Uvalde.

ESCAMILLA stated he does not know JAMES EARL RAY.
