ReBureau radiogram dated 5/21/68, which, among other things, instructs that offices covering State Capitols check at drivers license bureaus all drivers license applications for months of April and May 1968 concerning all male caucasians over 30 years of age and under 55 years, in view of the fact that it is possible subject secured driver's license using another name other than alias known. This instruction went on to say that as a result of reviewing these applications, Field Offices should conduct appropriate investigation to determine if any such individual identical with subject.

In prior communications to the Bureau and in telephonic conversations it has been pointed out that obtaining a list of the type prescribed would be extremely difficult, however, today the Texas Department of Public Safety furnished a list of some 4700 names who applied for licenses during the month of April. A cursory check of this list reveals that approximately 1000 of these individuals reside in the San Antonio Division, and to comply with reBuRadiogram, it would be necessary for this office to check out at least 1000 persons and the other offices in Texas the balance of the 4700.

Today I talked with Section Chief McGOWAN, Civil Rights Section at the Bureau, to advise that during the current year the State of Texas has required a proof of birth for all applicants applying for license. This requires a birth certificate, an insurance certificate in excess of five years, a religious certificate or appropriate educational records as confirmation.

I suggested to Mr. McGOWAN that since confirmation of birth is required in Texas, I felt that it would be desirable to limit this check for a span of less than 25 years as prescribed in reBuRadiogram to two to three years on each side of subject's known date of birth.

It was pointed out that it was ascertained that this number had been disconnected and SA GREB had a lead to ascertain the subscriber to this phone as of 12-16-67.

On May 29, 1968 SA GREB advised that records of the phone company reflect the former subscriber to this phone was the PHILLIP GARDENS NIGHT CLUB, 301 North San Marcos, San Antonio Texas and that the billing on this phone was to ARTURO RAMIREZ, 3251 West Laurel, SanAntonio, Taxas PE 3-1202.

After numerous attempts to contact MR. RAMIREZ, he was finally located late on May 29, 1968. MR. RAMIREZ related that he formerly managed this Night Club and that the phone was 223-0656.
