The conversation overheard involved a man who said he was an ex-policeman from Tennessee and he claimed he had a contract for \$5,000 to kill KING and that "in two days that black son of a bitch will be dead." She described this ex-policeman, whose first name is believed to be BOB, as follows:

FBI Cancels Pickup Order In King Case

MEMPHIS (AP)—The FBI issued, then withdrew, a request that Florida police help locate Eric Starvo Galt, a white man, as the investigation of the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. entered its second week.

Federal agents refused to say why they were seeking Galt, whose last known address was Birmingham, Ala.

Shot April 4

The bulletin distributed yesterday on the statewide police teletype network in Florida said Galt was driving a white Mustang.

Witnesses in Memphis told investigators earlier they saw a man in a white Mustang drive away from the rooming house from which King was shot April 4.

A source in the Dade County Public Safety Department in Miami said the FBI bulle-(Continued Next Page, Col. 7)

White Mustang Found

The FBI in Miami refused any comment.

At about the same time the pickup order was sent in Florida, federal agents in Atlanta impounded a white Mustang that had been parked since last Friday at a public housing project near the Georgia state capitol.

The message, withdrawn with the explanation that it was released by mistake, described Galt as a white male, 36 years old, about 5-foot-11 and 175 pounds with blue eyes and brown hair.

This roughly matched the

description circulated by federal authorities the night of King's slaying.

Special Agent John Hanlon of the Miami FBI office, who withdrew the pickup order about four hours after it was issued, said, "I cannot comment," when asked for further details.

The FBI in Memphis and Atlanta also refused to discuss the developments.

The Florida teletype message said Galt was last seen driving a white 1966 Mustang hardtop, Alabama license 1-38993. Birmingham police said this tag had been issued to Eric S. Galt, 2608 Highland Ave., Birmingham.

Bought in '66
State records in Montgomery, capital of Alabama, show that Galt listed his occupation as "merchant seaman, unemployed," when he applied for a driver's license in Birmingham in September 1967. The application showed Galt noted he had had a 1962 Louisiana driver's license but that it had expired.

FBI Keeping King Suspect Photo Secret

MEMPHIS, Tenn. (AP) — The Federal Bureau of Investigation is withholding nationwide distribution of a composite drawing of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.'s assassin, police sources said yesterday.

They haven't given us anything but a physical description," said one police official. "They aren't handing out pictures of the man. They either don't have a good one, or they're going it alone."

The official asked that his name not be used, citing the FBI's ban on comment about the investigation.

When Jacksonville, Fla., police questioned a Louisville, Ky., man Saturday night about the King slaying — the man since has been cleared of any connection — Police Lt. M. P. Richardson said, "It's a long shot, but he looks too much like the sketch of the man who is wanted in the King slaying."

Jacksonville police said yesterday the man was arrested after a resident noted a likeness to a composite picture which appeared in Florida newspapers. This sketch was prepared by a newspaper artist from the description given of the slaying. It was not released or endorsed by the FBI.

Residents of the Memphis rooming house from which King was shot April 4 reported last week that investigators had shown them composite drawings. They said the sketches were the same, or at least very similar, as those prepared by newspaper artists.

FBI Hunts Seaman In King Assassination

MEMPHIS (AP) — FBI agents from Virginia to Florida were hunting today for a man whose abandoned white Mustang fits descriptions of a car seen leaving the scene of the Martin Luther King Jrassassination.

The object of the search was Eric Starvo Galt, 37, known only as an unemployed seaman from Birmingham, Ala. A car registered in that name was seized by the FBI in Atlanta last Friday, eight days after King was shot to death in Memphis.

The FBI refused to acknowledge the hunt or to say why Galt was wanted. "No comment," was the routine reply.

Associated Press checks disclosed that FBI agents had contacted persons named Galt in several states, including Virginia, Alabama and Florida

An FBI alert for Galt was sent over the Florida police communications network last

Friday, but withdrawn four hours later.

FBI agents have continued to inquire about Galt at numerous places, including dry cleaners and service stations in Birmingham, where a man named Eric Starvo Galt rented a room at a Southside boarding hourse within the past eight months.

At Birmingham, the owner of the boarding house said today he had identified a drawing of a man sought in the King slaying as a roomer known by the name Eric Galt.

"It's him, I'm sure," said Peter Cherpes, 72, who runs a boarding house on Birmingham's South Side.

Cherpes consented to talk after the FBI responded to his request to be released from a secrecy pledge.

On April 2, 1968, at around 11:00 a.m. she went to the Valley Inn, 1405 East Main Street in El Cajon, and while there overheard a conversation pertaining to the racial situation in the United States. There were eight or nine people in the bar at this time. She advised that a big fellow known to her only as "BOB" did most of the talking. He said that he used to be a policeman in Tennessee, wbut after having a hassel with the sheriff he was fired and kicked out of Tennessee. He then stated, "I have a contract for \$5,000 to kill KING." Everyone, thinking he was joking, asked him if he heeded any help. He then stated, "I don't need any help from anybody and in two days that black S.O.B. will be dead."

She left the Valley Inn at this time and when she returned about an hour later BOB was gone. She has not seen him since.

She advised that the daytime bartender at the Valley Inn known as SARGE also overheard the conversation and she believes that SARGE knows BOB and might be able to furnish additional information.

BOYD YOUNG (SARGE), 198 North Gina, telephone 444-9205, El Cajon, California, was interviewed at the Valley Inn, 1405 East Main Street, El Cajon, and he furnished the following information:

He is the day bartender at the Valley Inn and BOB BRACKEN is a customer of his. He described BRACKEN as a fellow who is always telling unbelieveable stories and a little on the "crazy" side.

On April 2, 1968, while tending bar he overheard a conversation in which BRACKEN was involved. The conversation dealt with the racial issue. Someone then mentioned that some of these Negro leaders should be shot. He then heard BRACKEN say that he had a \$5,000 contract to kill KING. When everyone asked him if he needed any help he became very loud and said that he didn't need their help, that he could do it alone and that in two days he was going to kill KING.

that he was going to Memphis, Tennessee that same day. He then asked a customer named AL that if he would take him to the railroad depot he would give him \$500. YOUNG noticed that BRACKEN had a suitcase with him. BRACKEN and AL left and he has not seen or heard from BRACKEN since.

BRACKEN had previously mentioned to YOUNG that he was having marital problems and was planning on leaving the San Diego area for a while.

YOUNG believes that BRACKEN's wife lives at Sunrise Trailer Court on North Third Street in El Cajon. He described BOB BRACKEN as follows:

INGEBORG KATARINA BRACKEN, 2401 Willow Glen Road, telephone 442-3638, El Cajon, California, furnished the following information:

She has been married to ROBERT BENJAMIN BRACKEN for about 15 years. They are presently separated due to his strange behavior which began in 1964 when he was placed in a U. S. Naval Mental Hospital in Philadephia, Pennsylvania. He was interned for about five months and has never been the same since. He will be fine for a while, then suddenly begin to act rather strangely and do things which he later does not remember doing.

In 1965 he returned to active duty with the U.S. Navy and was stationed aboard the USS Saratoga. Three months later he had another breakdown and was placed in a Navy hospital in Germany, transferred to Italy and finally to the United States. He was released the same year from a Navy hospital in Largo, Florida. ROBERT BRACKEN's family also has a long history of mental illness. After he was released from the hospital and retired from the Navy they moved around steadily and never really settled down. About a year and a half ago they came to El Cajon, California and have been here every since. He had been working at Fowler Engineering in El Cajon until February, 1968.

In August, 1967, they separated and he went to Lead Hill, Arkansas and stayed with a friend named WAYNE RYAN. RYAN also has a history of mental illness.

Her husband came back to El Cajon in February, 1968 and they attempted to solve their marriage problems.

After seeing that they could not live together he decided to leave again and told her he was going back to his friend WAYNE RYAN in Lead Hill, Arkansas. He telephoned her from San Diego on March 30, 1968 to say goodby and she has not heard from him since.

She stated that he did not own any rifles and only had the hand pistol. She did not have a photograph of him.



DIRECTOR J. EDGAR HOOVER STATED THAT A FEDERAL COMPLAINT GALT WAS FILED BY THE FBI IN BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA, TODAY CHARGING GALODWITH CONSPIRING TO VIOLATE THE CIVIL RIGHTS OF DR. KING IN VIOLATION OF TITLE 18, SECTION 241, OF THE UNITED STATES CODE.

THE FBI COMPLAINT CHARGES THAT "ON OR ABOUT MARCHUXWON 29, 1968, AT BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA,...ERIC STARVO GALT AND AN INDIVIDUAL WHOM HE ALLEGED TO BE HIS BROTHER, ENTERED INTO A CONSPIRACY WHICH CONTINUED UNTIL ON OR ABOUT APRIL 5, 1968, TO INJURE, OPPRESS, THREATEN, OR INTIMIDATE MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.,...IN THE FREE EXERCISE OR ENJOYMENT OF A RIGHT SECURED TO HIM BY THE CONSTITUTION OR LAWS OF THE UNITED STATES; NAMELY, THE RIGHT TO FREELY TRAVEL FROM STATE TO STATE. IN FURTHERANCE OF THIS CONSPIRACY, ERIC STARVO GALT DID, ON OR ABOUT MARCH 30, 1968, PURCHASE A RIFLE AT BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA...."

ACCORDING TO MR. HOOVER, 77 30.06 RIFLE EQUIPPED WITH A TELESCOPIC SIGHT WAS FOUND NEAR A ROOMING HOUSE ON SOUTH MAIN STREET IN MEMPHIS IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE FATAL SHOOTING OF DR. KING OCCURRED. THE ROOMING HOUSE OVERLOOKS THE LORRAINE HOTEL AND MOTEL WHERE DR. KING WAS STAYING.

MR. HOOVER SAID THAT FBI AGENTS DETERMINED THAT THE 30.06 RIFLE HAD BEEN PURCHASED FROM A GUN DEALER IN BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA, ON MAREH

30, 1968. THE TELESCOPIC SIGHT ALSO WAS PURCHASED FROM THIS DEALER.

THE FBI DIRECTOR SAID THAT GALT, WHO HAS USED THE NAMES OF JOHN WI

LARD AND HARVEY LOWMYER IN THE PAST, IS THE OWNER

OF A 1966 WHITE MUSTANG BEARING ALABAMA LICENSE PLATES WHICH WAS
GEORGIA

LOCATED ABANDONED IN ATLANTA, GABRGIA, ON APRIL 11, 1968. INVESTIGATION

DISCLOSED THAT GALT PURCHASED THIS CAR FROM A PRIVATE CITIZEN IN

BIRMINGHAM ON AUGUST 30, 1967. THE MUSTANG'S ODOMETER SHOWED THAT

IT HAD BEEN DRIVEN MORE THAN 19,000 MILES BETWEEN LATE AUGUST, 1967,

AND EARLY APRIL, 1968.

ACCORDING TO MR. HOOVER, GALT'S TRAVELS IN THE MUSTANG INCLUDED TRIPS TO LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA; NEW ORLEANS, LOUISIANA; BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA; AND MEXICO, AS WELL AS TO MEMPHIS, TENNESSEE, AND ATLANTA, GEORGIA. GALT WAS REPORTED TO HAVE BEEN IN MEMPHIS ON APRIL 3 AND XAND, 1968, AND TO HAVE DEPARTED FROM THERE FOR ATLANTA.

INTENSIVE INVESTIGATION BY THE FBI HAS DISCLOSED THAT GALT HAS CLAIMED TO HAVE BEEN EMPLOYED AS A COOK ON MISSISSIPPI RIVER VESSELS AND AS A MERCHANT SEAMAN. HE IS SAID TO BE AN AVID DANCER AND TOOK DANCING LESSONS IN NEW ORLEANS IN 1964 AND 1965; IN BIRMINGHAM DURING SEPTEMBER AND OCTOBER, 1967; AND IN LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA, FROM DECEMBER, 1967, TO FEBRUARY, 1968.

GALT LEFT LOS ANGELES ON DECEMBER 15, 1967, AND DROVE
HIS WHITE MUSTANG TO NEW ORELANS, WHERE HE CLAIMED HE CONTACTED
EITHER AN ENGINEERING OR A CONTRACTING FIRM. HE LEFT NEW ORLEANS ON
DECEMBER 19TH AND ARRIVED BACK IN LOS ANGELES ON DECEMBER 21, 1967.

WHILE IN THE LOS ANGELES AREA EARLY THIS YEAR, GALT
TOOK A COURSE AT A SCHOOL OF BARTENDING AND WAS GRADUATED ON MARCH 2,
1968.

THE FUGITIVE IS DESCRIBED AS A WHITE MALE. HE IS APPROXIMATELY 5 FEET 8 INCHES TO 5 FEET 11 INCHES TALL AND WEIGHS BETWEEN 160
AND 175 POUNDS. HE IS SAID TO BE A NEAT DRESSER AND HAS A MEDIUM BUILD.
