In order to cover the possibility that subject may have died since commission of the crime, the U. S. Census Bureau and Department of Health, Education and Welfare were contacted and they advised that no central records of unidentified deceased are maintained by those agencies. It was suggested that each state may maintain such a record in their Bureau of Vital Statistics or similar agency.

There is no known Federal law requiring the maintenance of such information; and it is possible that if any record of unidentified dead is maintained, it would only be maintained at local police departments, morgues, medical facilities, or the like.

Each office covering state capitals should check to ascertain if such records are maintained, and if so, should check records for the period from 4-5-68, to date, for any information which might possibly identify subject Ray with unidentified deceased person over that period.

If there is no central record repository maintained in the various states or nationally in the case of Mexico and Canada, you should, in connection with your contacts with law enforcement agencies on this case or other Bureau matters, make appropriate inquiries relative to

unidentified dead for the period beginning 4-5-68; and if fingerprints on such dead are maintained, they should be compared with those on the Identification Order on Ray in order to effect identification or nonidentification. This should be handled in the normal course of business and only reasonable investigation should be pursued along these lines.

The Identification Division has placed an appropriate stop on unidentified deceased inquiries it may receive. If feasible, appropriate offices and Legats, Mexico City and Ottawa should place similar stops with appropriate state, local or national agencies in your territories.

On 5/13/68, H.L. DOERKSEN, Park Manager, San Elijo State Beach, Cardiff, California, was interviewed and advised as follows:

On 11/15/67, an individual representing himself as Mr. KEN VAZIRI, registered in Space 99, for a period of two days. The following day VAZIRI departed the park and has not been seen since that time. He registered at the park driving a 1967 Mustang automobile, bearing District of Columbia license 219-614. He listed his residence address as 3829 Warner Street, city and state not listed.

When VAZIRI departed the park he abandoned the following property and to date has not claimed it:

One sweatshirt;	one Coleman lantern;
one black bow tie;	one pillow;
one thermos	one pair of socks;
two ballpoint pens;	one 6x6 tent with poles,
two sleeping bags	stakes;

DOERKSEN advised that approximately one week ago he turned in the above property to the Encinitas Sub-Station of the San Diego County Sheriff's Office and advised them of the above information. DOERKSEN further advised that during the early part of November, 1967, the time during which VAZIRI was residing at the park, he was on vacation and consequently did not physically observe him. He advised, however, that to his recollection, a fellow employee, LOREN DIETZ, observed VAZIRI and is familiar with the matter.

On 5/13/68, LOREN DIETZ, 2139 Cambridge, Cardiff, California, was interviewed and advised as follows:

He is employed as a park officer at the San Elijo State Beach, Cardiff, California. During the early part of November, 1967 he recalls an individual registering at the park beach in Cardiff, California and shortly thereafter departing, leaving camping equipment behind. DIETZ stated that to his recollection the individual was driving a 1967 Mustang automobile, dark brown or dark green in color. He advised he does not recall the individual's name, but stated that he conversed with him and was advised by the individual that he was a "professional student" and was from Hawaii. DIETZ stated that the individual appeared to be well educated and did not possess a rural type accent. He described the individual as follows:

Age	Early twenties
Hair	Dark brown or black
Height	Approximately 5' 10"
Build	Slender - medium
Complexion	Dark

A photograph of JAMES EARL RAY was displayed to DIETZ whereupon he advised that the above described individual is definitely not JAMES EARL RAY. He further advised that the individual he observed was apparently Hawaiian.

In view of the above information, no additional investigation is being conducted regarding this matter.

At 9:25 am this date, Mr. JAY KINIKIN, 246 Broadway, Chula Vista, Calif., space 7, phone 427-8479, telephonically contacted this office and advised that he saw someone who resembles RAY in STAN's CHULA ROOM, 247 Broadway, Chula Vista on 5-17-68 (Friday) between the hours of 11:00 pm and 1:00 am. KINIKIN stated that this individual "never sat down", seemed to be a trouble maker and very antagonistic. The subject was trying to pick up some of the women that were in the room, especially a woman known as MARIA, the wife of a Portuguese fisherman who frequents this bar and allegedly has enough money to buy quite a few rounds every time she comes in. KINIKIN also stated that the bartender had to ~~make~~ break up a potential fight between the subject and another man at the bar.

KINIKIN advised that he saw the picture of RAY in Sunday's Chula Vista City paper and that it was at this time that the man in the bar last Friday evening came into mind. KINIKIN advised that this man was in his early 30's, 6' or better, close to 200# and his facial features bore a striking resemblance to RAY.

KINIKIN advised that he is not in the habit of frequenting bars but because of his wife's hospitalization he went to this bar to pass some time. KINIKIN may be contacted at his home after 4:30pm days as he works and cannot be contacted ~~there~~ there.

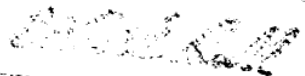
