

A call to telephone number 26200126 revealed that the Campbell Truck Co. is now located at 1500 fidelands 've in National City. Mr. Dwayne Campbell the owner teleponically advised as follows:

OLIVER was first employed by him as roximetely three years ago. He was subsequently released because he was not producing on the tob. OLIVER than went to work for the GEORGIA PACIFIC Co. in National Vity. He worked there for a while and than went to work as a deep sea fisherman. OLIVER came back to work for CAMPBELL on February 9, 1968 and quit his job on April 12, 1968.

MR. CAMPBELL stated that OLIV R was an excellent worker and that he hated to see him leave. According to CAMPBELL OLIVER stated hewas leaving because he was having a lot of trouble with his former wife. She has been in a lot of trouble for drinking and OLIVER has been paying her a lot of money for her support and the support of the two children. Recause of her drinking, however, the children are not benfiting from the money and OLIVER decided to leave the area and not pay her any more money.

CAMPBELL described OLIVER as follows:

Syronda JAMES EARL RAY, FBI #405 942 G. macaped Wissouri State Penitentiary (MSP) 4/23/67, and on 7/20/67 a complaint was filed before USC W. C. SHELRY, Jefferson City, Mo., charging RAY with unlawful flight to avoid confinement in violation of Title 18, USC, Section 1073. On 4/17/68 an authorized complaint was filed against ERIC STARVO GALT for violation of Title 18. USC. Section 241, charging that he did conspire to injure, oppress, threaten, or intimidate MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., in the free exercise and enjoyment of his rights secured by the Constitution of the United States. Complaint was filed before USC, Birmingham, Ala , by SAC JOSEPH H, GAMBLE, and a warrant was issued for the arrest of GALT. Recommended bond is \$50,000. On 5/7/68 Shelby County GJ, Memphis, returned a secret indictment charging JAMES EARL RAY with murder in the first degree. Chronological listing of subject's activities from 4/67 to 4/68 set forth and reflects he resided briefly at Montreal. Province of Quebec, Canada. He traveled to Birmingham, Ala., purchased a 1966 Ford Mustang, then traveled to Puerto Vallarta, Jalisco, Mexico, for a brief residence, and then to Los Angeles, Calif. Subject made 2 round trips by automobile from los angeles to New Orleans and in 3/68 established residence in Atlanta, Ga. Using the name HARVEY LOWMEYER, a Reminston, Model 760, rifle was purchased 3/30/68 Birmingham, Ala. At 6:00 P.M., 4/4/68 Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., was shot and killed by a single ballet fired from the bathroom of a mearby rooming house while he was standing on the balcony of the Lorraine Motel, Memphis. Same Remington rifle identified above recovered at scene along with other items and personal belongings of the subject. Results of Laboratory examinations of all evidence described herein. Interviews of relatives of JAMES EARL RAY, fellow prisoners, and associates set forth. Subject is described as a loner with no close associates, reportedly on amphetamine, and selling drugs at MSP while incarcerated there. Identification record and description also set forth ARMED AND DANGEROUS. -P-

The Laboratory concluded that the signatures ERIC S. GALT appearing on the Post Office form #1583 and the typewritten letter received by the mail forwarding service were prepared by the writer of the GALT signatures on other specimens unpitted.

ERIC S. GALT purchased a Bank of America Money Order #0799 17281 from the Bollywood Yestern Sranch, Bank of America, Hollywood, California. This money order was in the amount of \$7.50 and was made payable to the Locksmithing Institute, Little Falls, New Jersey.

The FBI Laboratory concluded that the ERIC S. GALT signature appearing on this money order was prepared by the writer of the signatures in this mams appearing on other specimes submitted.

A 1965 white Mustamp bearing 1968 Alabama license 1-3993 which was later determined to be registered to ENIC STARVO GALT, Birmingham, Alabama, who serviced at the H. Beckman Chevron Service Station, 1905 North Normandie Avenue, Los Angeles, California. The mileage at the time of this service charge was noted to be 34,185 miles.
