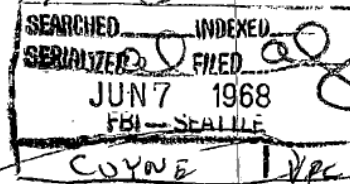

5/21/68.

Above radiogram requested that offices covering State capitals, will at Drivers License Bureaus check all drivers license applications for months of April and May, 1968, concerning all males over 30 years of age and under 55 years, in view of fact it is possible subject secured drivers license using another name other than aliases known. As a result of reviewing these applications, appropriate investigation should be conducted to determine if any individual developed is identical with subject.

On May 27, 1968, J. G. NELSON, Deputy Director, Washington State Department of Motor Vehicles, Olympia, advised that in order to check all applications for persons who have passed the examination, a run would have to be made on the computer. In order to have an accurate check for the requested months, due to the delay in submission and handling, Mr. NELSON stated that a printout showing approved applications by city would be completed by July 1, 1968.

He further stated that applications which for one reason or another have been dissaproved, i.e. failing test, are maintained by the individual driver examining station. A list of these stations is attached.

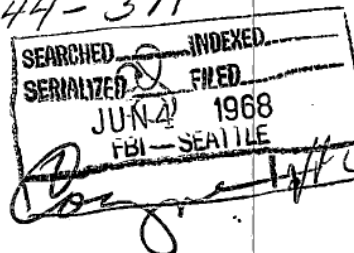

On 6/3/68, Mr. GEORGE STRINGER, Security Officer, K-Mart, Bellvue, Washington telephonically contacted the Seattle Office and advised that on Monday May 27, 1968, he apprehended a shoplifter at his store who resembled JAMES EARL RAY, and who he feels might possibly be identical with RAY. He stated that he first saw this man in his store about two weeks ~~after~~ after the assassination of Martin Luther King and he has seen him in the store several times since then but has not been able to prove that he had been shoplifting until the time he arrested him, although he was sure that he had been shoplifting. After arrestting the man he turned him over to the King County Sheriff's Office and he beleives he was booking into the King County Jail. He stated that although the man did not show him any identification he claimed to be Gerry L. Glazier and to reside at 137 160th S.E. Bellvue, and to be employed at Boeing. He claimed to be 44 years of age and born in 1924. STRINGER stated that there is a Gerald Glazier listed in the telephone directory at 137 160th S.E. telephone number SN 6-8372. Stringer stated that he had not planned to call the FBI but several people who saw the man he arrested and thought that he resembled RAY urged him to call and this is the reason he called a week after the incident. STRINGER stated he has re/ viewed photographs of RAY since he arrested GLAZIER and the person he arrested does resemble Ray, particularly from the side view.

He was described as having been born at Gladsnow, Monterey, Mexico. The manager of the Salvation Army advised that CONNER is described as 32 years, 170 lbs., 5'10", brown hair, butch cut, blue eyes. He very closely resembles the center photograph of the I.O. on RAY.

The witnesses who had seen CONNER were unable to identify him with any of the other photographs of RAY.

Accompanying CONNER was FABER OLSEN, SSN [REDACTED] 1838 E. 26th Street, Minneapolis, Minnesota, c/o BENJAMIN OLSEN; and WILLIAM MOLLETT, SSN [REDACTED] who was born in Van Lean, Kentucky, 5'6", 140, blue eyes, gray hair; father, JOHN B. MOLLETT; mother, SARAH MOLLETT, deceased; next of kin, MAY SPEAR, sister, Melvin, Kentucky.

The three individuals reportedly left Butte in a 1961 or 1962 light tan station wagon, make and model unknown. Before leaving Butte they tried to obtain gasoline from the Salvation Army, contacted other charities, including the Catholic Church, seeking to get money for gasoline.

SA FLEMING advised that they were supposed to be en route to Spokane and then Seattle. He requested that the Salvation Army and other charitable hostels in Spokane and Seattle be contacted to see if the suspects show up so CONNER may be identified or eliminated as being identical with RAY.

SA WALTON in Spokane was contacted to handle this lead immediately, and SAS WALTERS and DON ROGERS, the standby agents, in Seattle, are handling the lead in Seattle.

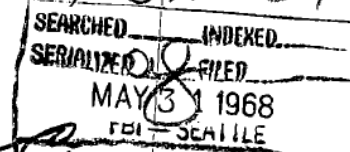
