On this date, MARLOW JACOBSEN, Operator of the Crystal Linen Supply of Wenatchee, 1016 Springwater St., Wenatchee advised that Thermo-Seal laundry tape bearing "20R-3" is not a number that he ever utilizes, as he uses a different marking system. He added that he uses many different color marking tapes but he uses the narrow tapes. He said that there are two different sizes of such marking tapes, narrow and wide. He would have to view the tapes to see if they were narrower or wider than his.

Regarding the mass communications media in Wenatchee RA territory, the Wenatchee Daily World has carried complete information regarding RAY, aka. GALT. All of the known departments and SOs in the territory have RAY's current IO, Wanted Flyer, bearing his aliases. There are no "hippie" rooming houses in Wenatchee but the Van Seaman Hotel, which caters to the transient trade has a copy of RAY's IO. He has called the writer(he, meaning the manager) on two other occasions regarding possible IO's being registered at his hotel and he has indicated that he will be alert to the subject, RAY registering there.

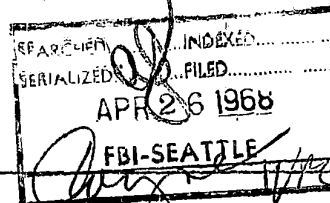

But you could find out his name etc. from U. S. Coast Guard at Seattle. I won't say he's the answer but age etc would be about right. As I had a peculiar

On April 23, 1968, MIKE PERUSSE who resides at 915 Knob Hill Avenue North and who is employed at the Standard Station at First Avenue South and Marginal Way, Seattle, Washington, advised that at about 9:45 am on April 23, 1968, an individual who resembled ERIC STARVO GALT came into his station driving a 1956 green Plymouth, two-door car bearing Idaho license IB23142.

PERUSSE described the individual as a white male, 40 to 45 years old, 5'9", medium build with dark hair. The individual was dressed in green slacks, brown sweater and brown shoes. PERUSSE advised that he also noted three expended .32 caliber automatic shells on the roof of the individual's car.

PERUSSE advised that he glanced in the vehicle and saw the registration card to read in part "THOMPSON - Pocatello, Idaho".

PERUSSE said that the man asked him for directions to the Bethlehem Steel Plant in Seattle as he was going to apply for a job there.

On April 23, 1968, Mr. URBAN PELLETEER, Personnel Director, Bethlehem Steel Plant, Seattle, and Mrs. EDNA BELNIAK, clerk - typist in the Personnel Office, advised that no one named THOMPSON giving an Idaho address had applied in the morning or early afternoon of April 23, 1968, for a job. Both of them advised that no one resembling ERIC STARVO GALT had come in to the employment office during the day to apply for a job. Mr. PELLETEER advised that his office is the only employment office for Bethlehem Steel in the Seattle area.

This is to insure that the Bureau will be immediately notified if the subject is arrested or comes to the attention of authorities with whom stops are placed.

Offices covering departure or arrival of overseas flights should have renewed stops, and subject's photograph should be displayed appropriately.

All offices should conduct appropriate investigation at all "hippie" rooming houses and similar establishments to obtain any information whatsoever concerning RAY.

The RAs, which are excluded from this memorandum, have been notified by telephone.

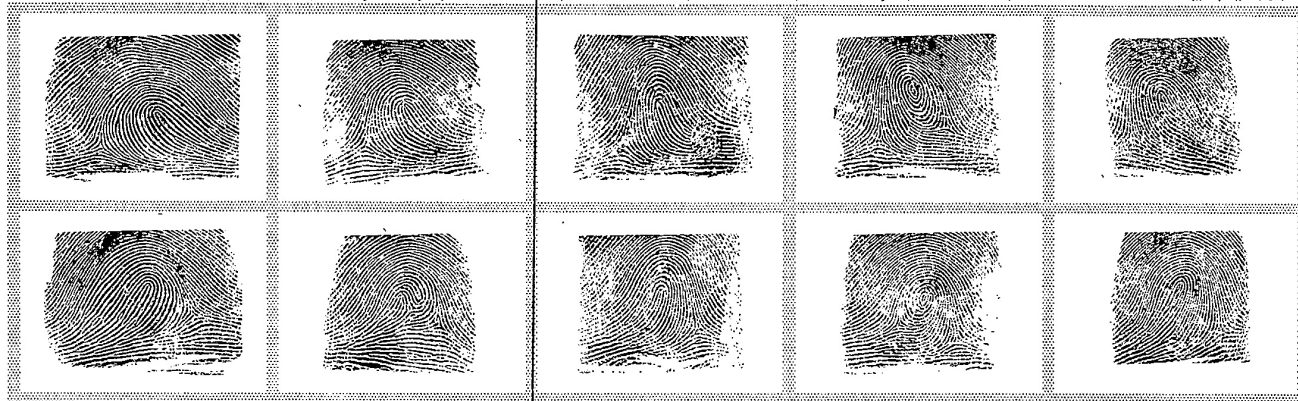

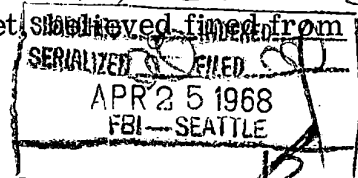

"TEN MOST WANTED FUGITIVES" PROGRAM

James Earl Ray, a Missouri prison escapee who has been sought under the alias Eric Starvo Galt in connection with the gunshot slaying of civil rights leader Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., has been added to the FBI's list of "Ten Most Wanted Fugitives."

FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover ordered the special addition of Ray to the "Ten Most Wanted Fugitives" list, which already contains ten fugitives, to insure the widest possible dissemination of Ray's photograph and description to help effect his earliest possible location.

Ray has been the subject of a massive and intensive search since the brutal gunshot slaying of Dr. King on April 4, 1968, as he stood on the balcony of a Memphis, Tennessee, motel. One rifle bullet, shot from the window of a nearby rooming house, felled the victim.



An exhaustive FBI fingerprint search, comparing latent fingerprints uncovered in the Dr. King case against fingerprints of over 53,000 persons on whom wanted notices have been posted in the FBI's Identification Division, succeeded in determining that Galt and Ray are identical.

A Federal warrant, issued at Birmingham, Alabama, on April 17, 1968, charges Ray, under the alias Eric Starvo Galt, with conspiring to interfere with a Constitutional Right of a United States citizen. Ray is also sought for unlawful interstate flight to avoid confinement after conviction for armed robbery, based on a Federal warrant issued on July 20, 1967, at Jefferson City, Missouri. He had been confined at the Missouri State Penitentiary, Jefferson City, Missouri, in March, 1960, with a 20-year sentence following conviction for armed robbery and operating a motor vehicle without permission of the owner. In September, 1966, while serving the sentence, he was confined for a time in the maximum security ward at the State Hospital, Fulton, Missouri. He was reported missing from the Missouri State Penitentiary since April 23, 1967.

Ray, who has an arrest record dating back to 1949 and has been convicted of burglary, armed robbery and forging United States Postal Money Orders, has also been confined in the Los Angeles County Jail, the Joliet and Pontiac, Illinois, State Prisons and the United States Penitentiary, Leavenworth, Kansas.

He served in the Army between February, 1946, and December, 1948, received a three-month sentence at hard labor for being drunk and breaking arrest and was given a General Discharge due to ineptness and lack of adaptability for military service.

Ray is a 40-year-old white male, reportedly born in Illinois on He is approximately 5'10" inches tall, weighs from 163 to 174 pounds, has blue eyes and brown hair which he has worn cut short. He has a small scar on the center of his forehead and a scar on the palm of his right hand. He has been described as having a straight, narrow nose and straight and even teeth and to have a nervous habit of occasionally tugging at an ear lobe. His left ear protrudes noticeably.

Acquaintances describe him as a "loner" and "drifter" whose language and diction reflect a "rural" quality and indicate he has had limited education.

He is reportedly a fan of western and country music, drinks vodka and beer, dresses neatly and claims past employment as a merchant seaman and cook on Mississippi River vessels. He is known to have worked as a baker, laborer and color matcher.

He is known as an avid dancer who has taken dancing lessons. He also completed a course at a school of bartending in the Los Angeles area early in 1968.

Ray should be considered armed and extremely dangerous. Anyone with information concerning this fugitive is requested to immediately contact the nearest office of the FBI, the telephone number of which may be found on the first page of local telephone directories.

THE CRIMES: Ray escaped from the Missouri State Penitentiary, Jefferson City, Missouri, on April 23, 1967, while serving a 20-year sentence for armed robbery and operating a motor vehicle without the owner's permission. He subsequently allegedly conspired, under the alias Eric Starvo Galt, to violate the civil rights of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., shot to death on the balcony of a Memphis, Tennessee, motel on April 4, 1968.

THE CRIMINAL: A 40-year-old white native of Illinois, who is known as a "loner" and "drifter" and has taken elaborate steps to establish a false identity, Ray has an extensive criminal record, including convictions for burglary, robbery and forging U. S. Postal Money Orders. Outstanding characteristics include a straight narrow nose, straight and even teeth, a noticeably protruding left ear and a nervous habit of tugging at an ear lobe. He has taken dancing lessons, attended bartending school, enrolled in a correspondence course in locksmithing and traveled widely in a 1966 Mustang recovered in Atlanta, Georgia, a week after Dr. King's murder. Ray likes western and country music, drinks vodka and beer and has worked as a baker, laborer and color matcher.

PROCESS: A Federal warrant issued at Jefferson City, Missouri, on July 20, 1967, charges Ray with unlawful interstate flight to avoid confinement for robbery. Another Federal warrant, issued at Birmingham, Alabama, on April 17, 1968, charges Ray, as Eric Starvo Galt, with conspiring to interfere with a Constitutional Right of a citizen.
