

With regard to the contacting of laundries as instructed in Butel 4/9/68, the following laundries in Sangamon County, State of Illinois, were contacted by SA JIPTY L. BERTHAY on 4/9/68. This was done in an effort to identify the laundry mark described in Butel of above date.

#### REMARKS

AAA Linin and Towel Springfield, Illinois

This establishment uses a paper having a printed number which is stapled to the garment and does not use the thermo seal marking equipment.

Arvins Laundry Springfield, Illinois

This laundry uses a pencil to mark the garment at time it is received and does not utilize thermo seal marking equipment.

Fink's Springfield, Illinois

Mr. FINK, owner and operator of this laundry, one of the largest in Springfield, Illinois; advised that thermo seal equipment is a sophisticated marking machine utilized by the larger laundries. His firm does not employ the use of this equipment; however, he did suspect that Lloyd's, Kennedy's, Springfield Laundry, and Gerber's Laundries of Springfield might possibly utilize this equipment in view of their size and volume of business. Mr. FINK said that to his khowledge there is no central location within the state of Illinois where laundry marks of various laundries are filed by laundry owners.

### REMARKS

Gerber's Springfield, Illinois

Mr. GERBER advised that thermo seal marking equipment was utilized by his establishment approximately five years ago; however, at the present time the polymark machine is utilized by his establishment.

Kennedy's Springfield, Illinois

Mr. BEHMER stated Kennedy's does not utilize thermo seal marking equipment and has never owned such marking device.

Lloyd's Springfield, Illinois

Mr. JACOB of Lloyd's Laundry advised thermo seal marking equipment is utilized by Lloyd's in connection with its processing and laundering of shirts. He was furnished the laundry mark identified in the above teletype and advised that this is not a laundry mark of his establishment.

Springfield Laundry Springfield, Illinois

Personnel at this laundry advised that this establishment uses paper tags which are attached to the garment during its processing; however, they are removed before the customer receives the completed laundry. He was furnished the laundry mark mentioned in re Butel and advised that this laundry mark is not any mark of the Springfield laundry.

Spring Street Laundry Springfield, Illinois

Personnel answering the telephone at this establishment advised that this is a coin operated laundry and customers handle their own washing.

Sally Wards Springfield, Illinois

Mr. JAKE WARD advised this establishment does utilize thermo seal marking equipment. His equipment marks the garment with a red tape listing thereon the number designated by the establishment at the time the garment is marked. He was furnished the laundry mark mentioned in re Butel; however, it meant nothing to him, and he commented that it was not any laundry mark of his establishment. Mr. WARD consulted with various publications he had . concerning various laundry marking equipment and advised he would suggest the only source who would know the location of thermo seal marking machines in the State of Illinois would be the Textile Machine Manufacturing Company of Syracuse, N. Y. who manufactures this piece of equipment. He said the machines can be purchased through distributors in St. Louis and Chicago; however, these distributors usually order the machine from the manufacturer.

Colonial Cleaners Auburn, Illinois

Personnel at this establishment advised the laundry received is furnished to Kennedy's in Springfield, Illinois, for processing. This establishment did not own any type of laundering equipment or marking devices since it is handled at the above laundry.

#### FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

Date April 11, 1968

BILLY RAY KING was interviewed at the Rock Island, Illinois, Police Department, by ROBERT A. WICKWIRE and CHARLES E. SMITH who identified themselves as Special Agents of the FBI. KING was warned of his rights and he waived them as shown on an executed warning and waiver form.

BILLY RAY KING advised he has resided for ten years at 102 Arlington Street, Lake Providence, Louisiana. He has been employed as a deck hand on different boats in the Mississippi River since he was 18 years of age. He stated for the last three months he has been employed as a deck hand on a towboat for the K.G.W. Towing Company out of Greenville, Mississippi.

He added that he had been injured on his boat approximately twenty days ago and had been treated at the Greenville, Mississippi, General Hospital, but had been recuperating at his home in Lake Providence, Louisiana. He had recovered and arranged to catch his boat, which is the George Weathers, at Quincy, Illinois. His Personnel Director, JERRY WILSON, with the K.G.W. Towing Company in Greenville, Mississippi, had given him an airplane ticket from Greenville, Mississippi, to St. Louis, Missouri, to Quincy, Illinois, for April 5, 1968; however, he determined that all planes were full and was instructed to take a bus to Memphis, Tennessee, to catch a plane to St. Louis. He left his home by Trailway Bus around noon on April 4, 1968 and proceeded to Memphis, Tennessee, which is about 175 miles. He arrived in Memphis sometime in the afternoon probably around 4:00 p.m. While at the Trailway Bus Depot. the riots broke out due to the shooting of MARTIN LUTHER KING. He advised that the bus depot was closed. There was no busses allowed to leave or enter and the people in the bus depot were forced to remain in the depot all night long. He advised that the depot was only two or three blocks from the Lorrdine Motel in Memphis, Tennessee, where KING was shot. He advised that he knows where this motel is located as he had stayed there on previous occasions. He added that it was general knowledge in all the papers that Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING was in Memphis and staying at the Lorraine Motel.

KING stated that he did not shoot MARTIN LUTHER KING but hastily added even if he had done so, he would not tell. He also stated that MARTIN LUTHER KING got just what he deserved and that the people in the North are getting just what they deserved on this racial problem as they caused the whole thing. When asked if he was a member of the KKK, KING stated that he was not a member but also added even if he was, he would not tell.

KING then stated during the early hours before daybreak, the busses started to move and he was able to take a taxi to the airport. He recalled that the fare was somewhere around \$4.65. When he arrived at the airport, he determined that there was only one plane that he could catch to Quincy, Illinois; however, this plane was full and he was placed on stand by. When the plane left and he could not get on, he then made a long distance telephone call to his boss JERRY WILSON who then told him to catch a bus to St. Louis and a bus to Quincy where he could catch the boat. He advised that he took a cab back to the bus depot where he boarded a Trailway Bus for St. Louis, Missouri. He advised this was early in the morning and arrived in St. Louis sometime around noon. He then caught a bus from St. Louis to Quincy; however, this bus made many different stops and he arrived too late in Quincy to catch the boat. He then took another bus to Rock Island, Illinois, where he now awaiting for the boat which is due to arrive at 12:00 madeight.

KING stated that he owns a 1967 bright blue Mustang which is at his home at Lake Providence, Louisiana. He explained that the papers for this car are in the name of his friend TRAVIS SHEFFIELD, who lives approximately three blocks away on Foster Street. He stated he bought this car from SHEFFIELD and is making the payments but he has not had the papers changed over to his name. The car is at his home. KING also admitted that he owned a .38 pistol and a shotgun which are both at his home.
