Reverend GRIMES was telephonically contacted on the evening of April 9, 1968, and advised that he had no information regarding possible racial violence in the Quad City area as a result of the assassination of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING. JR.

On April 11, 1968, Reverend GRIMES was contacted at 1209 Ninth Avenue, Rock Island, Illinois, and advised that he personally felt that the racial violence occurring the night of April 10, 1968, in Rock Island, Illinois, was the work of amateur hoodlums. He advised that his reasons for feeling this way were:

- 1. The poor job of making the incinerary devices, inasmuch as some of them did not ignite;
- Only one incinerary device placed at the location of each incident;
- 3. Through the time of day, indicating that this was juveniles trying to avoid the curiew.

Reverend GRIMES advised that he had contacted numerous homes in the Rock Island west end area where teenagers resided. He stated that in those homes where teenagers lived that might be lead to acts of violence, he had requested that the parents keep the boys in during the evening hours.

At 7:38 AM,4/16/68,SA EMMETT A. SCHMITT telephonically

advised as follows:

WILLIAM MATHEWS, 1501 Wiley Drive, Urbana, had just called Springfield, Office to report he had seen a man in the Ill. Central RR freightyard, Champaign, during the early AM hours of this date, who answered the description of the composite of the KING killer. MATHEWS said he was an ICRR employee.

Writer and SA DELMAR A. CAIN established contact with MATHENS and he advised man seen by him was observed by him in the freightyard on several occasions from about 2:30 AM on; that he had come in on a freight train from New Orleans; that he had slept in the old yard office during the night, and that he, MATHEWS, had given him 50¢ for breakfast as he was broke. MATHEWS said man was dirty and dishelveled with a several days growth of beard. According to MATHEWS, the man asked for directions to local "skid row" and said he was planning to go to Chicago. MATHEWS last saw the man at Clifford Jacobs Restaurant, adjoining the freightyard, where he was having breakfast just before 6:00 AM.

MATHEWS accompanied writer and SA CAIN to the freightyard where man in question was found asleep on the second floor of the old yard office. He was interviewed with the following result:

He identified himself as MILFORD GEORGE TASKER, aka MEL TASKER. He is an unemployed common laborer from Baltimore, Md. He was last employed as an attendant at Transit Truck Stop, Inc., near 3altimore, where he worked about 3 weeks during late Marchearly April, 1968. He exhibited a statement of earnings form from this employer showing that he was last paid \$41.69 on 4/5/68. He also exhibited a sales slip showing a purchase of clothing 4/6/68 from Benny's Army and Navy Store, 600 E. Baltimore St., Baltimore. His last address there was 116 S. Broadway, Baltimore. He has a brother, PAUL WILLIAM TASKER, residing 113 Van Dor(ph) Terrace, Dundalk, Md. Claimed to have been in Baltimore since about 8/67 until he left hitchhiking to New Orleans on or about

4/8/68. Caught a ride with a girl named AVON(ph)(Lnu)driving a new model red Pontiac. She was enroute to her home in Maysville, La. and let him out at Leesville, La. They spent 2 nights on the road. He caught a bus in Leesville on in to New Orleans. Paid \$7.00 for a bus ticket. Spent night of 4/11/68 in New Orleans bus terminal and night 4/12/68 in mission for bums called Ozanam Inn, 843 Camp St., New Orleans. He exhibited a card confirming this and showing he was assigned bed #62 at the mission. Tried to sleep in park night of 4/13 but run out by PD and told to leave town. Had tried to get work in New Orleans 2-3 days thru local Manpower office but unsuccessful. Started to hitchhike to Chicago but couldn't catch a ride. Hopped freight and would up in Champaign freightyard early AM 4/16. TASKER is W.M.A and further described as follows:

DOB:4/9/37,POB: Keyser,W.Va.,5'112",150,thin build,brown hair, blue eyes,52" vertical scar on stomach; tattoo of black panther on left forearm,tattoo "Mel" left upper arm near shoulder. Served Army,1961-63,SN US honorable discharge. Immediately prior to last employment in Baltimore, he was jailed there for 90 days-charge-assaulting a police officer. Prior to this rap, he had been out only 8 days from serving a 30 day jail in Baltimore, again for assault. Chaimed he had once used alias HAROLD CONNER while hiding from his wife who was looking for him for non-support. Claimed he had been in Tennessee only once in his life and that was while driving thru enroute Louisiana with AVON(ph)(Lnu), mentioned above. Claimed she was a nicely dressed young girl and had picked him up for company because she was afraid as a negro had thrown a rock thru her car window.

Documents in TASKER's possession seemed to confirm enough of his story to eliminate him.
