On April 19, 1968, DAVID CLARENCE ORT was interviewed at his home at 1709 Harvest, Cahokia, Illinois, by SA BERNARD E. CURRIGAN and SA LARRY W. GREEN.

CRT was interviewed concerning his knowledge of ALBERT PEPPER and his associations with a person named PEPPER. ORT denied any knowledge of PEPPER and stated that he is totally unfamiliar with the person identified to him as ALBERT PEPPER. ORT further stated that on occasions, the DOSSETTS would receive calls from persons unknown to him but when such calls came to his home for the DOSSETTS. he would go next door and get them to come and answer the telephone. He stated that he ordinarily knew who was calling since it was the DOSSETTS close relatives in Belleville, Illinois. ORT stated if DOSSETT received a call from either Mr. or Mrs. ALBERT PEPPER, such telephone call is unknown to him and that certainly it was not a call charged to his telephone number.



On 4/24/68, Mr. L. J. O'BRIEN, Model Star Laundry. 208 East Van Buren, advised that the laundry mark 20R-3 was one that his laundry had used. O'BRIEN stated that the 20 is the lot number. The R represents the week and the 3 represents the bundle number. O'BRIEN stated that the Tetter is changed every week and a check of his calendar indicated that the last week he had used the letter R was the week of December 3-9, 1967 and during that week, his tape machine was using yellow tape. O'BRIEN stated that his record showed that bundle 3 was checked into the laundry on 12/11/67, which was a Monday. He said that the record showed that bundle 3 was picked up by driver ED ORR who had route #5. O'BRIEN stated that this was the only information that could be determined about this bundle at this time because all of the tickets with the customers' names on them had been destroyed. O'BRIEN stated that bundle 3 of lot 20R had been washed on 12/11/67 as a part of load B and this load included bundles 1-18. O'BRIEN stated that the yellow tape marker 20R-1 and the yellow tape marker 20R-18 appeared on his slip to indicate that this was the first and the last bundle in load B on this day.

Mr. ED ORR stated that he had been driving for Model Star for about ten years and knew most of his regular customers very well. ORR said that he rarely ever got a bundle of laundry from a stranger. ORR said that he remembers picking up a bundle from a stranger at 805 North Walnut several months ago but he cannot recall what this person looked like. ORR said that when he returned the laundry to the 805 address, the individual told him that he was moving. ORR said that in addition to approximately eighty regular customers, he also picks up laundry at the Holiday Inn, the Grier-Lincoln Hotel, and the Plaza Hotel. ORR stated that the bundle 20R-3 did not come from these establishments, however, because their laundry was always on a special and if it had been picked

up the week of December 3-9, 1967, it would have been washed during that week, also.

ORR viewed pictures of JAMES EARL RAY and stated that the individual at 805 Walnut was much younger than the photograph of RAY appeared.

JANICE BARKER, secretary, Brumaghim Real Estate, 302 West Fairchild, advised that her company handles the rental of the apartment at 805 West Walnut. Miss BARKER checked the records for 805 North Walnut and advised that a WAYNE FEGETT occupied the apartment from 11/8/67 through 11/7/67 when he was asked to move. Miss BARKER stated that FEGETT caused the other tenants trouble by being very demanding and the other tenants were afraid of him. She stated that he also had damaged the apartment by removing water pipes and electrical wiring and they had received word that he had burned down a house in Chrisman, Illinois. BARKER stated that the record indicated he paid his last week's rent on 12/7/67 and would have moved sometime during the next week. BARKER said that a Mrs. CHARLES NORWELL lived in the apartment above FEGETT and was one of the tenants who had complained about FEGETT's activities.

BARKER stated that FEGETT told her that he was going to Iowa to enter a hospital for treatment. She said that she had not seen WAYNE FEGETT since 12/7/67.

JANICE BARKER viewed photographs of JAMES EARL RAY and stated emphatically that FEGETT and RAY were not identical. She stated that FEGETT was a smaller, younger, individual and had reddish - blond hair.

Mrs. EVELYN NORWELL, 805 Walnut Street, advised that she remembered the tenant who lived at 805 (downstairs) in December of 1967. Mrs. NORWELL stated that this man had entered her apartment on several occasions, without permission, and used the telephone. She said that he had made calls to Chrisman, Illinois on two occasions and she had received the bill for them. She stated that he had been very demanding of she and her husband and requested that they take him different places. She said that they had taken him to the Plaza Hotel to pick up his belongings

when he first moved in but on subsequent demands by FEGETT, they had refused.

Mrs. NORWELL stated that FEGETT had a sister, Mrs. MARTHA FEGETT, who ran a beauty shop in Hillery, Illinois.

Mrs. NORWELL viewed photographs of JAMES EARL RAY and stated that this was not the individual that she had known as WAYNE FEGETT.

The following information is a summary of information determined by credit and criminal checks at the Danville, Illinois PD, the Vermilion County, Illinois Sheriff's Office, and the Credit Bureau of Vermilion County.

LAWRENCE WAYNE FEGETT, FBI #536719E has been arrested on several occasions by the Danville, Illinois Police Department and the Vermilion County, Illinois Sheriff's Office for various charges including drunk and disorderly, public intoxication, disorderly conduct, and criminal damage to property. These arrests date back to 10/30/60 and the last arrest shown was 1/19/65 on a charge of battery. On 4/24/68, Mr. L. J. O'BRIEN, Model Star Laundry. 208 East Van Buren, advised that the laundry mark 20R-3 was one that his laundry had used. O'BRIEN stated that the 20 is the lot number. The R represents the week and the 3 represents the bundle number. O'BRIEN stated that the Tetter is changed every week and a check of his calendar indicated that the last week he had used the letter R was the week of December 3-9, 1967 and during that week. his tape machine was using yellow tape. JANICE BARKER, secretary, Brumaghim Real Estate, 302 West Fairchild, advised that her company handles the rental of the apartment at 805 West Walnut. Miss BARKER checked the records for 805 North Walnut and advised that a WAYNE FEGETT occupied the apartment from 11/8/67 through 11/7/67 when he was asked to move. Miss BARKER stated that FEGETT caused the other tenants trouble by being very demanding and the other tenants were afraid of him. 


