Referenced communication indicated that upon completion of proposed circular letter, 1,800 copies should be sent to Chicago, 1,800 copies should be sent to Indianapolis and 700 copies to St. Louis.

Prior to approval, it will be necessary for the Bureau to know exactly the cost of the preparation of the circular letter, as well as the cost of distribution. You should, therefore, advise the Bureau the exact cost for you to distribute these circular letters and by what means they are being distributed. The preparation of the circular letter will be held in abeyance pending the receipt of the cost data from you.
