


Mr. WAYNE W. WADMAN, Customer Service Manager, Browning Arms Company, 1706 Washington Street, St. Louis, Missouri, advised the printed number "130712" appearing in the upper left corner of the label on the Browning High Power Rifle box found in this case, is a code designation which means the weapon it contained was a Safari grade, .243 Winchester caliber, Browning Rifle, with light weight barrel and sights.

The handwritten number appearing in the lower left corner of the label is the serial number of the weapon.

Browning high power rifle serial numbers consist of four arabic numerals, which are the actual serial number of the weapon, followed by a letter of the alphabet, known as the "Alpha designation", which is indicative of the caliber and grade of the weapon. This is followed by a single arabic numeral which is indicative of the last digit of the year in which the rifle was manufactured, in this case 1965.

Browning files fail to disclose any record of receipt or shipment of any .243 Winchester caliber, Safari grade rifles bearing serial numbers 4444Z5 or 4449Z5.

Serial number 4Y44Z5 is not a proper Browning serial number, as the first four digits are not arabic numerals, but was considered significant by Mr. WADMAN as being indicative of some question as to the second digit.

Mr. WADMAN explained that the serial numbers are handwritten in French script arabic numerals, which are sufficiently different in form in some instances to cause Americans considerable difficulty in correctly reading or interpreting them. In his experience, what may appear to be a "Y" is actually either a "1" or a "7".

Based on this possibility, search was made for serial number 4144Z5 with the result that no record was found.

Browning records for serial number 4744Z5 disclosed a .243 Winchester caliber, Safari grade, Browning rifle, bearing this serial number was part of a shipment destined to All American Sporting Goods, 1025 Chapala Street, Santa Barbara, California, on April 4, 1966, pursuant to Browning invoice number 017794 dated March 30, 1966, customer order number 0016265 and number 0016248.

This weapon was subsequently returned to Browning by the dealer, for credit. There is no way of knowing whether or not it was returned in the original box.

This rifle was later part of a shipment to Aeromarine Supply Company, 5701 Airport Highway, Birmingham, Alabama, on October 21, 1966, pursuant to Browning invoice number 079679, dated October 17, 1966, customer order number 0001420 and number D001232. This is the last record Browning has of this weapon.

Mr. WADMAN stated that he felt almost sure that this rifle, serial number 4744Z5, was the one referred to by the box label in this case, but that it would be necessary for him, or some other experienced Browning employee, to view either the original label or a clear photograph thereof in order to effect a positive identification.

Mr. WADMAN is in lawful custody of pertinent Browning records, and is the proper person to whom a subpoint duces tecum should be directed for their production in court.

He indicated that to him the artists conception resembled BENJAMIN FRANKLIN GIBSON, Imperial Wizard of the Missouri Klan.

HoDGINS also stated that another employee of the service station, JIM (LNU), age 35 to 40, of High Ridge, Mo., believes he may have rented a car to GIBSON last week. **EXECUTE** HODGINS stated he did not know how to get hold of JIM (LNU), however, he would be to work in the service station on monday, 4/8/68.



Per ASAC callwas made to Memphis to determine if there is any identification of assassin or not so as to have some idea whether we should be running out all calls to identify this person.

At 1;35PM this date called Memphis, SA JOSEPH HESTER, to whom KING case assigned. He said there is no indication at all as to identity of assassin and that any info we receive as to killer should be run out. He said the shot killing KING was fired at 6;00PM 4-4-68 and any should be considered suspect whose whereabouts cannot be determined at that time. He said Bureau has latent prints of killer for comparison, and if possible prints should be taken of suspects, including palm prints, for submission to Bureau for comparison.

He also daid that Bureau has an artist now in Memphis to make a new artists conception of suspect. Latest description of suspect is:

Age 26 to 40 (they tend to favor a young age near 30) Weight 155-180
Probably tall and slender
Dark brown hair (definitely not black)
Getaway car in all probability is white mustang.



REV. OLIVER W GIBSON, PARISH TEMPLE CME CHURCH, EIGHT HUNDRED NORTH UNION (NEGRO MINISTER) ADVISED THAT HE WAS MASTER OF CEREMONIES IN MEMORIAL TO KING TODAY AND AFTER EVENING SERVICES IN HIS CHURCH ABOUT NINE PM HE WAS TOLD A WHITE MAN WISHED TO SEE HIM. THIS MAN GAVE HIS NAME ONLY AS "COLLINS". HE WAS FIVE FEET EIGHT AND ONE HALF INCHES TALL, RUDDY COMPLEXION. BLONDE STRAIGHT HAIR, SMALL SCAR LEFT HAND, SCAR RIGHT CHEEK, ONE FIVE FIVE - ONE SIX ZERO LBS. ABOUT THIRTY YEARS OF AGE. WELL DRESSED IN DARK GREEN BUSINESS SUIT WITH SHIRT AND TIE. HE WORE WATCH WITH BLACK FACE ON LEFT HAND AND RINF ON RIGHT RING FINGER WITH "H" ON IT. AT END OF INTERVIEW WITH GIBSON HE SAID HIS REAL NAME WAS THOMAS ROBERT HENDERSON. AFTER IDENTIFYING SELF TO GIBSON HE SAID HE WAS NOT A BEGGAR BUT WAS A THIEF AND A MURDERER. HE CLAIMED TO HAVE TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS IN COUNTERFIET CHECKS IN AN ATTACHE CASE HE WAS CARRYING, TOGETHER WITH SEVERAL CREDIT CARDS. HE CLAIMED HE CAME TO ST. LOUIS FROM CHICAGO MORNING FOUR SEVEN SIXTYEIGHT, METHOD OF TRANSPORTATION UNKNOWN. END PAGE ONE

E SAID HE WANTED TO FIND PEACE. CLAIMED HE WAS RECENTLY IN ATLANTA AND HAD RECENTLY MET MARTIN LUTHER KING WHO BEFRENDED HIM. HE TOLD KING HE HAD BUT ONE YEAR TO LIVE DUE TO BRAIN TUMOR. HE HAD CARD WITH KINGS NAME AND HOME AND OFFICE TELEPHONE NUMBER. HE DID NOT SO STATE, BUT GAVE THE IMPRESSION TO GIBSON HE WAS THE ASSASSIN OF KING BY STATING HE HAD ORDERED SOMEONE KILLED. HE WONDERED IF HE SHOULD TURN HIMSELF IN. HE SAID HE HAD STUDIED PSYCHOLOGY, HAD BEEN IN THE MILITARY AND WON BOTH BRONZE AND SILVER STAR. HE HAS USED NARCOTICS. HE WANTED GIBSON TO HELP HIM FIND PEACE. HE HAD ONLY EIGHTEEN CENTS IN CASH. GIBSON GAVE HIM FIVE DOLLARS. HE WANTED GIBSON TO HELP HIM AND SAID HE WOULD MEET GIBSON AT THE CHURCH AT TEN THIRTY IN THE MORNING (OF FOUR EIGHT SIXTYEIGHT). HE SAID ALTHOUGH HE WAS WANTED BY THE FBI AND MAFIA "THEY CAN'T CATCH ME."

SL FILES CONTAIN ON THOMAS ROBERT HENDERSON (BUFILE 105-132449) WHO MAY BE IDENTICAL TO HENDERSON, ABOVE. THE HENDERSON IN BUFILE IS NOTED AS HAVING SUICIDAL TENDENCIES, WAS ONCE NARCOTICS USER, IS MENTAL CASE, DRIFTER, NUMEROUS ARRESTS AND HAS FBI NUMBER SEVEN ONE NINE THREE TWO ZERO C.

At 11:15PN 4-7-68 Supv. AL HOGAN, Division 6, Bureau called to advise that MILTON LEWIS, Compliance Officer, U.S. Dept of Justice, home phone WO 1-3452 called one ED O'CONNELL, U.S. Dept of Justice in Washington, D.C. (who notified the Bureau) that he, LEWIS, had a call from a Rev. GIBSON, telephone 361-1350, that he, GIBSON, had talked to a man who was the killer of KING.

Mr. HOGAN desired that we contact LEWIS, then GIBSON and submit teletype or telephone reply to Bureau, whichever would be most appropriate.

I called Mr. LEWIS at WO 1-3452 and he said that GIBSON was Rev. OLIVER W. GIBSON, minister, Parish Temple CME Church, 800 N. Union, who had a white man visit him after the evening service and he thought this white man had killed KING. He said that GIBSON did not call the FBI, St. Louis since GIBSON had an unpleasant experience with the FBI in Little Rock, Ark. some time in the past. He said GIBSON was at the home of a friend and that was telephone 361-1350.

I called REV. GIBSON at this number. He maid he was the master of ceremonies for KING memorial at Forest Park today (4-7-68) and after this he held his services at regular time at his church at 800 N. Union. After these services at about 9PM a white man who gave his name as ---- COLLINS, described as 5' 8½" (same height as the minister), ruddy complexion, straight blonde hair, small scar left hand, scar right cheek, 155-160 lbs., about 30 years of age. He was well dressed in a dark green business suit, shirt and tie. He wore a watch with black face on his left wrist and had a ring on his right ring finger with an "H" on it. He said he was not a beggar, but was a thief and murdered. He claimed to have \$10,000 in ficticious cashiers check in an attache case he was carrying. He said his home was in New Orleans and that he had come to St. Louis from Chicago, method of transportation unknown. He said he had ordered people killed and had killed some himself. He said he was wanted by the FBI and the MAFIA.

He said he wanted to find peace and wanted to kjow what to do.

He said he had recently been in Atlanta - had ordered people killed, and on one recently was carried out, but the \$500. fee for it was not paid. He said once in Atlanta he met M.L.KING who befriended him and he told KING he had only one year to live since he had a brain tumor. He had a card (calling card) with M.L.KING name, home and business phone on it. He supposedly talked about the existence of God, right and wrong, etc with KING. He said he had only $18 \not c$ in cash on him. He said he had stolen MAFIA records and asked if he should turn himself in. He claimed to have been in the military, won the bronze and silver star. He again said he was searching for peace. Said he and not slept in 3 days. He womdered if GIBSON could help him. GIBSON wondered what he could do and COLLINS asked to meet him in the morning at 10:30AM at the church. GIBSON agreed to this, and asked if he needed money. repeated he was not a beggar, but accepted a "loan" of \$5.00 from GIBSON. He said he was tired of running - staying in dingy hotels. He said he had some bags in a locker. He repeated having killed people and was sorry. He again talked about KING. He finally said his name was not COLLINS, but he had used phoney names. He said his name was THOMAS ROBERT HENDERSON, was wanted by the FBI but "they can't catch me"as in 4 hours he could be in California. He started to leave the attache case with GIBSON but didn't do it as GIBSON's life wouldn't be worth a nickel if he did. He left going out to Enright Ave. toward Union on foot and was not seen thereafter.

It was the talk about the killing that made BIBSON think he was the killer of KING. He Fold he had used narcotics and had studied psychological

SL indices indicate one THOMAS ROBERT HENDERSON, born has description similar to that above and HAS ATTEMPTED SUICIDE IN PAST, IS AN ADMITTED NARCOTICE USER, HAS RECEIVED PSYCHIATRIC TREATMENT, AND SHOULD BE CONSIDERED DANGEROUS. HE IS MENTAL CASE AND A DRIFTER.



Sergeant CHARLES O'BIREN, Fourth District Detective Bureau, St. Louis Police Department, telephonically advised this date that a JOHN RICHARD THOMPSON was approached by him at the Warwick Hotel, St. Louis, Missouri, based on information received from the East St. Louis Chief of Police to the effect that JOHN RICHARD THOMPSON resembled the composite photograph appearing in the paper concerning MARTIN LUTHER KING's killer.

O'BIREN stated that THOMPSON stated that he lost his billfold since he was in St. Louis and that he was driving a yellow Dodge Charger. He stated that THOMPSON was described as being 5 feet 11 inches, 130 pounds, white male, blond hair and blue eyes. THOMPSON advised him that his address was 1767 Nashville Road, Bowling Green, Kentucky.

O'BIREN stated that THOMPSON appeared to be a homo and that he would further check him out concerning his residence during the latter part of last week.

O'BIREN subsequently re-contacted this Office and stated that THOMPSON was taken to the Biltmore Hotel where he said he was residing temporarily and that he was identified as, being there on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday and in room 457. He then moved to the Warwich Hotel, room 851 on Friday, which was April 5, 1968.

For your information, pertinent periods in the investigation are 3-29-68 and 3-30-68 in Birmingham, Alabama and 4-4-68 in Memphis, Tennessee.

In the event any data is developed re suspects and if interested offices can establish whereabouts of suspects on dates above, this may eliminate the suspects. If this cannot be done, efforts should be made to secure photographs of suspects in question and forward photos to Memphis and Birmingham for possible elimination. Pertinent descriptive data should be included with photos.

If unable to eliminate on basis of established whereabouts in pertinent periods, interested offices should make efforts to secure fingerprints of suspect in question and submit same to Bureau for elimination.

Composite description based on data developed in Birmingham and Memphis is as follows:
