FBI Number 743 226 B, Army Serial Number as the operator of the Home Service Laundry and Dry Cleaning Company, 5280 Hollywood Boulevard, Los Angeles. This laundry uses laundry tags similar to the tags that appeared on the clothing of Unsub in the MURKIN case at Memphis. The code on the clothes recovered is the code used subsequent to February, 1968, by this laundry.

This laundry is within five blocks of the Rompage Hardware Store where a pair of pliers recovered in Memphis originated. VERNON sold his laundry and removed all the records and tools from the premises March 24, 1968. He was last seen in Los Angeles March 27, 1968.

VERNON served in the military service apparently in the inclusive period 1953 through 1961, dates unspecified. He was assigned to Fort Campbell, Kentucky, May 1, 1953, when he went AWOL. He surrendered to military authorities in Birmingham May 6, 1953; left again, then surrendered again, this time at Laredo, Texas. May 9. 1953. His record indicates he was born at Pampa, Texas. His father's name is JAMES MACK TERNON of Los Angeles, California. A description furnished by Los Angeles indicates in 1961 he was 5' 11", 195 pounds, brown eyes, brown hair.



Efforts to contact Reverend BROWER on 4/8/68 disclosed that he was out of town and would return late on that evening.

On the morning of 4/9/68 SA WILLIAM R. BURTON interviewed Reverend FLOYD BROWER, 1709 Big Bend, Poplar Bluff, Mo., concerning the statements he made from the Senath, Mo., Methodist Church pulpit that he was sorry to hear of KING's death, but would be even "sorrier" when the announcement was made identifying the person who did it. The Reverend BROWER advised that the basis for this statement was an article in either the St. Louis Globe Democrat or one of the local Southeast Missouri newspapers, which stated that the search for MARTIN LUTHER KING's assassin had spread to the Bootheel area of Missouri and that he was possibly from Pemiscot County. He also had heard several "rumors" that the assassin was from Pemiscot County. He advised he had no other basis whatsoever for making the statement, had never heard anyone mention any names of a possible assassin and was now sorry that he had made such a statement from the pulpit.

Relatives were listed as the mother, residing in Kennett; the father in Benton Harbor, Mich.; a brother, WILLARD BENFIELD, JR., of Benton Harbor, Mich.; a brother, CHARLES R. BENFIELD, Phoenix, Ariz., and brother, DONALD L. BENFIELD of Kennett, Mo. The pallbearers for this funeral were JOE CHESIRE, BILL BRADSHAW, HERSHEL WAYNE and three other individuals, all of Kennett.

JOE CHESIRE, 1509 Wimberly, employed Kennett Outboard Motor Service, on First Street, and BILL BRADSHAW, 804 Court, owner of Kennett Outboard Service, advised that WILLARD BENFIELD, SR., and WILLARD BENFIELD, JR., arrived in Kennett as they recall on Tuesday or Wednesday, 4/2 or 3/68. At any rate, BRADSHAW was positive that he had seen WILLARD BENFIELD, SR., and JR., at the funeral home in Kennett on Thursday evening, 4/4/68, also on Friday, 4/5/68. He believed that they left to return to Benton Harbor on Saturday, 4/6/68.

Enclosed herewith for the offices receiving this communication are five codes each of three studies done by Bureau artists of the UNSUB in captioned matter.

Photo #1 is based on information furnished by witnesses at Memphis, Tennessee. Photos #2 and #3 are based on information furnished by witnesses at Birmingham, Alabama.

Witnesses who have observed our principal suspect, ERIC STARYO GALT, and witnesses who observed UNSUB alone in Memphis and Birmingham have displayed enough similarity in their descriptions and reaction to artists' conception to indicate that UNSUB and GALT are probably identical.

Investigation to date indicates it is entirely possible that GALT identity is fictitious and was established as a cover.

The best description we have appears to be the description of GALT which was furnished

Witnesses, however, have described UNSUB as both taller and shorter, heavier and lighter, and there is an uncertainty about the hairline and eyes. The best photo appears to be #1. Photo #2 is highly regarded if he appeared a bit more youthful. With the limitations set forth herein, the description set forth for GALT may be regarded as the best composite description at this time:

At 11:30 p.m. on 4/9/68, Rev. HAROLD DEAN HEADY of 7300 Virginia Ave., St. Louis, Mo., telephonically advised SA PETERSON that he is pastor of the Friendly Assembly of God Church and is acquainted with an individual reportedly arrested by authorities in Joplin, Mo., p.m., 4/9/68, in connection with the slaying of MARTIN LUTHER KING. He stated that this individual is a mental case; that he has on several occasions attempted to befriend him by furnishing him food, clothing, and money. He has observed him sleeping in cemeteries and in parks in St. Louis and on one occasion paid his bus fare when he said he wanted to return to his parents in Palmer, Texas. After placing the individual on a bus he discovered that he had left the bus and apparently cashed in his ticket and never left St. Louis.

At 11:45 p.m., 4/9/68, this information was telephonically furnished to SA JAMES A. BENBROOK of the Kansas City Office. SA BENBROOK said that the individual picked up by Joplin PD was then being interrogated in Joplin and it was the opinion of the interviewing agent that he was a mental case. The man's name is LYNN RAY CLEVELAND.




