ATTORNEY GENERAL RAMSEY CLARK ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT THE FBI HAS IDENTIFIED JAMES EARL RAY. AN ESCAPEE FROM THE WISSOURI STATE PENITENTIARY. AS ERIC STARVO GALT, AGAINST WHOM A FEDERAL COMPLAINT WAS FILED LAST WEDNESDAY IN CONNECTION WITH THE FATAL SHOOTING OF THE REVEREND DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.

DIRECTOR J. EDGAR HOOVER SAID THAT A SYSTEMATIC AND EXHAUSTIVE SEARCH OF LATENT FINGERPRINTS UNCOVERED IN THE DR. KING CASE AGAINST THE FINGERPRINTS OF THE OVER 53,000 PERSONS FROM WHOM: "WANTED NOTICES" HAVE BEEN POSTED IN THE FILES OF THE FBI"S IDENT-IFICATION DIVISION LED TO THE DETERMINATION THAT GALT AND RAY ARE IDENTICAL.

MR. HOOVER SAID THAT RAY, WHO IS 40 YEARS OF AGE, WAS REPORTED MISSING FROM THE DISSOURI STATE PENITENTIARY AT JEFFERSON CITY, MISSOURI, SINCE APRIL 23, 1967. HE HAD BEEN RECEIVED AT THAT INSTITUTION ON MARCH 17, 1960, TO SERVE A 20-YEAR SENTENCE FOLLOWING CONVICTION IN ST. LOUIS FOR ARMED ROBBERY AND FOR OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE WITHOUT PERMISSION OF THE OWNER.

IN SEPTEMBER, 1966, WHILE SERVING THIS SENTENCE, HE WAS CONFINED FOR A TIME IN THE MAXIMUM SECURITY WARD AT THE STATE HOSPITA AT FULTON, MISSOURI.

ACCORDING TO MR. HOOVER, RAY HAS A KNOWN ARREST RECORD DATING BACK TO 1949. PRIOR TO THE 1960 CONVICTION FOR WHICH HE RECEIVED THE 20-YEAR TERM, RAY HAD BEEN CONVICTED OF BURGLARY IN LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA, IN 1949; ARMED ROBBERY IN CHICAGO, ILLINOIS, IN 1952; AND FORGING UNITED STATES POSTAL MONEY ORDERS IN MISSOURI IN 1955.

HE HAS SERVED TERMS IN THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY JAIL IN

1949; IN STATE PRISONS AT JOLIET AND PONTIAC, ILLINOIS, IN 1952-54;

AND IN THE FEDERAL PENITENTIARY AT LEAVENWORTH, KANSAS, IN 1955-58;

RAY WAS AN ENLISTED MAN IN THE UNITED STATES ARMY FROM FEBRUARY. 1946. TO DECEMBER, 1948, AT WHICH TIME HE WAS GIVEN A GENERAL DISCHARGE DUE TO INEPTNESS AND LACK OF ADAPTABILITY FOR MILITARY SERVICE. WHILE IN THE ARMY, HE RECEIVED A THREE-MONTH SENTENCE AT HARD LABOR FOR BEING DRUNK AND BREAKING ARREST.

MR. HOGVER SAID THAT DUKING HIS CRIMINAL CAREER, RAY HAS ALSO USED THE NAMES OF JAMES MUSRIDE, JAMES WALTON, W. C. HERRON AND JAMES O'CONNER. HE IS A WHITE MALE; CLAIMS TO HAVE

BEEN BORN IN ILLINOIS; IS APPROXIMATELY S FEET

10 INCHES TALL AND WEIGHS ABOUT 163 TO 174 POUNDS. HE HAS BLUE EYES AND BROWN HAIR. THERE IS A SMALL SCAR ON THE CENTER OF HIS FOREHEAD AND A SCAR ON THE PALM OF HIS RIGHT HAND.

RAY HAS CLAIMED THAT HE ATTENDED SCHOOL THROUGH THE 10TH GRADE IN ALTON, ILLINOIS. HE HAS HAD THE REPUTATION OF BEING A "DRIFTER" SINCE LEAVING SCHOOL. HIS VOCATIONAL EXPERIENCE INCLUDES WORKING AS A BAKER, LABORER AND COLOR MATCHER.

IN CONNECTION WITH HIS ESCAPE FROM THE MISSOURI STATE

PENITENTIARY, AN FBI COMPLAINT WAS FILED IN JEFFERSON CITY.

MISSOURI, ON JULY 20, 1967, CHARGING RAY WITH UNLAWFULLY FLEEING

FROM THE STATE OF MISSOURI TO AVOID CONFINEMENT. HE HAS BEEN A

FEDERAL FUGITIVE SINCE THEN.

RAY SHOULD BE CONSIDERED ARMED AND EXTREMELY DANGEROUS.

The following investigation was conducted by SA's William R. Duncan and James Duff

At Center, Missouri

Mr. John Rodgers, Cashier, Center State Bank on 4/19/68 advised that a Mr. Jerry Raynes resides about 42 miles S.E. of Center on a small acreage he purchased at a Sheriff's sale Sept. 6th, 1967. At that time he saw Mr. Raynes an elderly man, as the bank had an interest in the sale of this property. He states he has not seen him since. He suggested a reliable person to contact would be Mr. Harold Maiden, the next door neighbor of Mr. Rayne.

Mr. Harold Maiden, Rte. 2, Center on 4/19/68 advised that Mr. Jerry Rayne bought the next door property in the fall of 1967. Maiden states he lives alone (Raynes) has two cars, a 1967 Nash Rambler, Tan, and a White over Red 1961 Plymouth. Maiden stated this man is retired, but has indicated he had eight children and had been married twide. The mother of his children is dead. Mr. Maiden stated that a younger woman and two small childred have visited Raynes on ocaassional weekends since he has been there, but no other persons have visiteddhimmto his knowledge. Mr. Raynes appears to be 69 and is on Social Security. He has a telephone AM 7 3467.

Observation of Mr. Raynes property on 2/19/68 indicates it is located next to Center City dump, and is situated on a knowl. The house is small, appears to have two or three rooms and 2 cars. One is a tan Nash, the other a white over red Plymouth, both parked in the yard. Lights were on in the house, and when first observed, one male individual could be observed inside.

The above information was furnished the SAC and Supervisor Welton. It was decided that the reporting agents should immediately contact Mr. Raynes for information concerning the fugitive. The house was approached, no activity was observed. It was determined to be a two kerroom home. On command Mr. Raynes came to the door, appearing as if he had been amleep. The agents entered the bed-

room, checked it, found it to be sparsely funished, and there after checked the kitchen. Mr. Raynes was then interviewed.

Mr. Jerry Raynes, Rt. 2, Center, on 1/19/68 advised that he is 69 years of age, having been born that he was married to Lucille Maher, now deceased, and 8 children were born to this marrigge. Raynes was fuzzy in his ability to recall specifics, doubts that all the children are his, and knows nothing at all of John. He is sure, however, that subject is his own child. The children are as follows: Franklin, aka Buzzy, or Buzz, deceased (killed in accident at Quincy, Illinois on a bridge at about 1958); Next child is James Earl, born Alton, Illinois, 1928; Carol Pepper, Bellevue Ave., Maplewood; Melba Ray, apparently of Quincy, Illinois, a mental case who has been in the Illinois State Hospital at Jacksonville; and Susie address unknown, who were given away by their mother after the separation, and Jerry who resides in Chicago.

Mr. Raynes stated he has had little contact with his children during the past 17 years, except for Carol. He last saw the subject seventeen years ago, and has had no direct contact with him since.

Raynes stated he know James had been in the penetentiary from news items and from information from subjects mother Lucille. He stated that his wife Lucille became and alcoholic when they lived in Ewing, Mo., and later in Quincy, Illinois. It was this latter place that they were separated.

Raynes stated he has always used the name of Raynes, but some of the children have used the name Ray. He understands that the subject has used several aliases.

He stated he knew nothing concerning subjects implication in this matter until he received phone calls from his daughter Carol stating that the FBI had contacted her concerning Jim. He stated he received two calls tonight, one from Carol, and the other from Melba each stating that news items indicated Jim was involved in Dr. King's murder. He stated he did not know how Melba learned of his whereabouts as he had not seen or heread from her for the past 7 or 8 years. She indicated she was calling from Quincy, Illinois, but he knew now more about it.

Raynes was warned of the seriousness of the investigation, of the provisions of the harboring statute. Raynes promised his cooperation should be receive any information concerning subjects whereabouts. He states he particularly had barred his doors as he is afraid of the subject, and concerned that he might try to contact him. He stated he wants no part of the subject.



At 10:55 A. M., 4/19/68, ASAC JAMES L. MIDDLETON, Cincinnati, telephonically furnished the following:

During the evening of April 18, 1968, two young boys stated that they had observed an individual at the airport in Columbus, Ohio, who was a lookalike for ERIC STARYO GALT. He was inquiring about accommodations for a flight to Los Angeles. In view of inclement weather at Columbus no flights were leaving. Investigation by Cincinnati determined that this suspect took a cab to the Greyhound Bus Terminal in The cab driver stated that he resembled Columbus. He paid his cab fare with a roll of dimes and also had a roll of nickles in his possession. He informed the cab driver that he came in from Cleveland. He purchased a Greyhound bus ticket, number 6333776, for Los Angeles, leaving Columbus, Ohio, 4:30 A. M. on Greyhound bus, number 4472, scheduled to arrive St. Louis 2:30 P. M., April 19, 1968. The driver of the bus changed in Indianapolis.

On 4-19-68, the wbiter and SA JAMES E. LINDSAY contacted Mrs. IDA MAY HUNTT, owner of the rooming house located at 3959 Folsom, SLMO. Mrs. HUNT viewed a photograph of ERIC STARVO GALT as depicted on WF # 442. She advised that she had no one of similar description and appearance residing at that address. She further advised that most of her boarders are older men. She said the boarders were at that time eating supper. A visual observation of the boarders in the dining area revealed that all were men appering to be in their 50's or 60's with the exception of one white male in his late 30's, over six feet tall, approximately 220 pounds, with a receding hair line.

Mrs. HUNT advised she knew of no one being seated on the front porch that evening. She pointed out that she has no new tennants.


