Mr. FRANK VAN BREUSEGEN, pharmacist at Medicare Pharmacy, 623 North Grand, was interviewed and furnished the following information: to SA JOHN O. TRETHEWEY. JR.:

VAN BREUSEGEN said a man whom he believed resembled the description and photograph of ERIC STARVO GALT had entered his drugstore at approximately 1:00 AM on 4/19/68, and had requested stimulants to keep him awake for about 12 hours. He stated that the man was about 5'9" to 10", 150 to 160 lbs., medium brown hair, worn combed back, with most of it angled toward the right side but with no part. In comparing this individual with the libest photo available of JAMES EARL RAY. he stated that the photo was quite similar except that the individual who had come into his drugstore did not have a double chin and his face appeared thinner. He thought that this individual's eyes gave more of the appearance of brown than blue, more hazel or greenish. He was dressed in a tweedy medium blue, inexpensive two button suit with the top button buttoned. He conversed with a type of accent which he described as being like country Southern Missouri accent. He wore a white shirt with long wing tipped collar and a dark tie. He was very calm, very definite, very careful and never raised his voice during his brief conversation with the druggist. He definitely wanted a stimulant, but refused No Doz which was recommended by the druggist. He appeared from the look in his eyes to be greatly fatigued.

Although it was raining slightly at the time that this individual came into the store, he was not at all wet. VAN BREUSEGEN followed him out of the drugstore just a few seconds behind but he was out of sight by the time he left the front door. (It is noted that the side of the drugstore is adjacent to a wide area where a car could have easily been parked out of the druggist's view; and also that an alleyway crosses that alley running north and south immediately behind the drugstore so that the individual could quickly have disappeared from the view of anyone looking down the alley from the street. Information received from authorities at the Missouri Training School for Men, Moberly, Missouri, that inmate DELANO ELMER WALKER, white male, inmate number 14273, when interviewed on November 20, 1967, shortly after his admission, told the interviewing officer of several incidents. The interviewing officer's report says, "Walker has mentioned several bizarre incidents including the allegation that he was contacted to assassinate Martin Luther King.

WALKER has a history of mental illness and when interviewed concerning this by prison officials, this date, was very vague.

WALKER advised to reporting agent that he is a white male, born at Elvins, St. Francois County, Missouri. He received three years for assault on October 6, 1967. He admitted being in Barnes Hospital in St. Louis and the State Mental Hospital at Farmington, Missori.

He said that several months ago, while drinking in a bar in St. Louis about 8 blocks from the Goodwill Store and close to a new Pontiac agency, two men got to talking to him concerning the racial situation. One of them gave him \$50 and told him to go home, that they would see him a few days later concerning the possibility of him assassinating Martin LUTHER KING. Three or four days later, three men in a new Buick drove to his house at Elvins, Missouri, and he told them he was not interested in their proposition. His wife, RUTHANN WALKER, who presently resides at Elvins, Missouri, allegedly saw these men. Shortly after this incident, he was taken to the State Mental Hospital at Farmington, Missouri.

Memphis tel dated 4/22/68 requested major law enforcement agencies to compare unidentified latent prints in robberies and burglaries with fingerprints of subject RAY.

Officer MICHAEL FITZPATRICK, Identification Division, SLPD, made this comparison at SLPD with negative results and Officer ED BRIGHT conducted the same investigation at the SLCPD with negative results. This data was furnished to SA HAROLD R. DOBSON for daily teletype summary.

On 4/25/68, Det. Sgt. JAMES HACKETT, Ninth District, SLPD, advised that GLEN BLACK, driver of Checker Cab #127, reported to Ninth District that he picked up a man shortly after midnight at the McArthur Hotel on the night of 4/24-25/68 and that he drove this individual to Boyle and Forest Park where he let him out of the cab. The passenger in the cab reportedly had a large roll of currency in his possession at the time.

BLACK advised the PD that he was formerly animate at Jefferson City Penitentiary, that he was there at the same time subject RAY was there and that he knew RAY for this reason. He said the man that he picked up at the McArthur Hotel looked very much like RAY and he thought that it may have been RAY.

According to HACKETT, Ninth District detectives immediately after this information was reported to them by BLACK searched the area saloons, etc., near Boyle and Forest Park Avenues from 1:30 until nearly 3:00 in an effort to locate this individual without success. Additionally, they talked with the bellhop and desk clerk at the McArthur Hotel who advised the officers that the man who was picked up by the Checker Cab was refused lodging because he was drunk and he did not look like RAY, whose photographs both had recently seen in the paper and as a result of contacts with police and the FBI.
