Re memorandum of SA JACK J. FISHER dated 4/23/68, reporting information from ROBERT JOSEPH TRINGALI who encountered an individual at the Stadium Club in East St. Louis, Illinois, later identified as BRIAN EVERETT GALLAGHER.

It will be recalled that available photographs of RAY were shown to TRINGALI who said definitely they did not resemble GALLAGHER.

Communication was had with the Kansas City Digision which forwarded mug shots of RAY taken at the Missouri State Penitentiary, January 4, 1966. These were the photographs which were displayed on KSD-TV on the evening of April 22,1968, and were the photographs which TRINGALI desired to view again as he thought them reminiscent of GALLAGHER. Upon display of these photographs to TRINGALI, on April 25, 1968, TRINGALI said he was satisfied that GALLAGHER is not identical with RAY. He displayed the picture to his girlfriend, unnamed, who was with him when he was confronted with GALLAGHER and reports that she, too, was of the opinion that the man who identified himself to them as GALLAGHER is not RAY.

No further investigation is being conducted on this matter.

GASLIGHT BAR AT KANSAS CXTY, MISSOURI

On 4/29/68, O. F. MYEKS, City Liquor Control Director, Kansas City, Missouri, advised SA ROBERT V. HARMAN, JR. that according to his records, the first Gaslight bar licensed in the city was licensed on 7/11/60, at 1403 Main Street, and had formerly been licensed at the same address as the Trade Winds Bar. A Gaslight bar has operated continuously in the city since that time and is presently operating at 3740 Broadway, Kansas City, Missouri.

On 4/30/68, RODNEY BOJECK, Bartender and Assistant Manager, the Gaslight Bar, 617 Central Street, Kansas City, Kansas, advised SA ROBERT V. HARMAN, JR. that that bar had been operating under that name only since about 1962, and was definitely not operating under that name prior to 1960. He explained that there had been no other Gaslight bar in Kansas City, Kansas.

Since a bar known as the Gaslight was not in operation in Kansas City prior to subject RAY's arrest and continuous incarceration beginning on 10/16/59, no investigation will be conducted at Kansas City, Missouri, to locate any girl friend of subject RAY whom he may have met at such a bar.
