

Cask :

After pleading guilty to a charge of Larceny of a Motor Vehicle. John Ryan was received at Henard on June 2, 1953, from Adams County, under sentence of one to twenty years with the court Ekking the term at five to ten years.

STATE'S ATTORNEY'S REPORT: At about 5:15 p.m., on April 5, 1956, the defendant, in company with an unknown associate, stole a 1942 Hudson sedan in front of a home in Quincy, Illinois. On the morning of April 7, 1955, the defendant and the car were discovered in Riverside Park in Quincy. At the time, the front seat of the car was on fire and subject was asleep. The police awakened Ryan and helped to extinguish the flames. While in the Adams County Jail, the defendant attempted to escape; however, the plot was thwarted.

IINAL PD:

Information from the Federal Bureau of Investigation shows that subject has the following criminal record:

On January 24, 1950, he was received at the Indiana State Reformatory at Pendleton, under sentence of two to five years for Burglary (2nd degree). He was paroled on March 51, 1952, but he abscounded from parole.

On December 3, 1952, he was arrested at Holtville, California, as a sleeper, and released the next day.

ITUTIONAL RD:

Subject has received 3 punishment reports (1 major and 2 minor), for violation of the institutional rules. He has been assigned to the Inmate's Kitchen for the past 3 years and nine months.

ROUND:

This 26 year old white man tells that he was the third of four children and was born at St. Louis, Missouri on to native parents. He is either unwilling to give the true history of his parental background, or else is unaware of the facts of them. We note that some of the parental history given by his brother, Jerry, who served at Menard (#23737), is quite contrary to that which the inmate gives. The inmate reports that his father, Gerald Ryan, and the mother, Lucille, age 48, apparently separated during his early youth. He is unable to give any information as to the cause of their separation, and states that he knows nothing about the details. In any event, he lived with his mother and the siblings, and his mother has worked considerably as a waittress. He tells that his mother soon married Jerry Rayns, an auto mechanic, and their adjustment was rather poor together. He states that his stepfather was a poor worker, and the family received considerable relief assistance during the depression years. The inmate tells that there were 2 or 3 periods of separation, the last coming about 1952. We note in the report from his brother, ferry, that the parents separated in 1953, allegedly because the father ran away with a woman, who was the mother of a St. Charles

The immate does not know whether Training School inmate. his mother and stepfather are divorced. He states that he always adjusted well with the members of his family, and tells that he lived with them until 14 or 15 years of age when he left to seek employment. He states that he has been at home very little since that time. He reports that his mother is now residing at 536 York Street, Quincy, Illinois, and is dependent upon ADC assistance. He does not seem to know whether his father ever remarried, and indicates that he has assumed his father to be deceased. He tells that he has 2 brothers, Jerry and James. The brother Jerry was paroled from Menard in December, 1955, violated his parole, and is now serving a term at the Missouri State Prison. The brother, James, is residing in Chicago. He states that he has 2 half brothers, and 3 half sisters. One or two of the half sisters, he thinks, are residing with his mother in Quincy. Illinois.

ment of the brother, Jerry to Menard, for Larceny, Jerry also served in St. Charles Training School for Robbery, and was later sentenced to Sheridan Reformatory for participating in a riot at St. Charles. He is now serving at the Missouri State Prison on a five-year sentence for Robbery. His brother, James, also served at Joliet and Pontiac. He has been receiving correspondence once or twice each month from his mother and a half sister, but none of the family have visited him to date.

GIONAL:

This inmate was born in St. Louis, Missouri, but the family seems to have been rather mobile during his early youth. He indicates that he lived awhile in Palmyra, Missouri, and was in Galesburg, Illinois for 2 or 3 years. He then moved to Adams, Illinois where they lived a year or two before going to Quincy, Illinois. He apparently left home while the family was residing in Quincy. He continued to live around Quincy most of the time until his commitment to the Indiana Reformatory in January, 1950. Following his parole from there in March, 1952, he went to live with an uncle at Alton, Illinois. He remained there a short time, and then went to Chicago where he has resided most of the time since. He made a trip to California on one occasion, covering a short period of time. About January, 1953, he went back to Quincy, Illinois where he continued to reside until the present offense. He spent part of the time there with his grandmother, but seems to have been living in hotels with his brother at the time of the prosent trouble.

ICATION:

He claims to have completed grade school at Adams, Illinois before quitting at 14 or 15 years of age. He tells that he also attended school while at the Indiana Reformatory, and

estimates that he has about 2 years high school credits. Psychometric tests indicate average intelligence.

RK STORY: This subject has maintained a rather casual work history. After quitting school at Adams, Illinois about 1945 or 1946, he began following odd jobs, having had employment as a farm hand, paper boy, and worked briefly at the Golf Course. He later went to Quincy, Illinois where he worked 4 months for the Weems Laundry, and 2 or 3 months at a Nursing Home. He tells that he also had various other odd jobs in that community. In January, 1950, he was committed to the Indiana Reformatory where he remained until paroled in March, 1952. He was sent to Alton. Illinois to live with an uncle, and tells that he worked there for about 3 yeeks in a service station. He worked one day at the LaClede Steel Company. He then went to Chicago, and tells of working about 3 months at the Green Acre Riding Stable in Oaklawn. He worked about a month for the Chicago and Northwestern Railroad, and about 2 weeks at the Piper Bakery Company. He had a few other odd jobs in Chicago. He made a trip to California, and finally returned to Chicago, where he continued to work at odd jobs. In January, 1953, he went to Quincy, Illinois, and claims to have worked about 3 months at the Midwest Chemical Company. At the time of the present difficulty, he had been unemployed a short time.

RITAL STORY:

This immate has not been married.

RSONAL CTORS:

The subject seems to be in good health at the present time, and has no definite physical complaints. He has a rather decided speech defect. There is no known venereal history. He denies ever having been a user of narcotics, but admits that he has been an occasional intemperate user of intoxicants (beer), since his release from the Indiana Reformatory in 1952. He enjoyed movies, sports, dating, car riding, dancing, pool, loafing, and frequenting taverns. Concerning this offense, he readily admits guilt, telling that he had been drinking at the time and stole the car in question to use as a means of transportation after being "mixed up in a burglary," He claims that he had no associates in this offense although we suspect that he did have at least one associate. He was previously incarcerated in the Indiana Reformatory for Burglary of a service station, but claims that he did not participate in that and was asleep at the time of the alleged burglary. He apparently came from a broken home situation, and had very limited opportunities during youth. He has had a limited amount of schooling, and has never had steady employment for eng length of time. He is a rather inadequate, somewhat dull appearing person who seems to be somewhat evasive in the interview situation. He has made a fair institutional
