At 4:57 p.m., 4/5/68, an individual identified himself as ELBERT G. RUDASILL, 1509 T Street, S. E., Apartment 4, Washington, D. C., telephone 584-9762, telephonically contacted WFO. RUDASILL advised he is employed as the Technical Director, York Employment Service, 1522 K Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. He advised as follows:

He wanted to suggest the name of an individual as a possible suspect in the murder of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. He identified this individual as JAMES AIERS, the spelling of whose surname he was not certain, a counselor, Technical Department, York Employment Service. AIERS is described as a white male, age 24, 6', 170, blond hair, who usually wears horn-rimmed glasses. AIERS likes to go hunting and owns several firearms, the descriptions of which RUDASILL was unaware of.

RUDASILL said he was furnishing AIERS' name only because he fits the general description of unsub and owns firearms. In addition he has learned that around noon, 4/4/68, AIERS and his wife left for a trip to Miami, Florida, in their automobile.

RUDASILL said he knew nothing about the political feelings of AIERS or his feelings toward Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. He had no information which would connect AIERS with Dr. KING's murder.

Mrs. MARJORIE ULEN, 1515 Ogden Street, N.W., telephone 291-6320, advised SA JEROME E. VEIGLE on 4/6/68 that she worked in Congressman GEORGE RYDER's office during 1965 - 1966, when the Congressman was defeated. Congressman RYDER represented the Ninth Congressional District of Tennessee.

Mrs. ULEN advised that during the period she worked in the Congressman's office she recalls that on a regular basis they received "hate cards" from one J. C. WILLARD, 3454 Chelsea Street, Memphis, Tennessee. Mrs. ULEN noted that she read that one WILLARD was named in a local newspaper as being a suspect in the assassination of KING.

She stated that Congressman RYDER's office records are now housed at the Memphis State University Library at Memphis.





HURD that a collect call had come to the White House from Lansing, Michigan, STUCKEY advised they at first declined the collect call until the operator indicated it had to do with the assassination of KING. Call accepted and a male individual stated he knew who killed KING and immediately hung up.

The suspect was described as being 5' 9" to 5' 10"; 145 to 150#; ruddy complexion; long, straight nose, wearing khaki pants. The nose was described as being the single thing that caused the observer to feel the suspect might be the assassin.

The observer was described as being a physician who had furnished his name to the officer but had requested that he not be identified unless necessary. The sighting took place at 11:45 AM.

ROSENBAUM said that he knew that YOUNG knew people from the area "down there". ROSENBAUM said that he had passed it off at the time and thought no more about it, but felt that since the statement had been proven true he felt that he should advise the Bureau. Search of premises believed occupied by Unsub who assassinated Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING on 4/4/68, disclosed suitcase in which was located tee-shirt and undershorts bearing laundry mark on red tape with black lettering believed to be thermoseal type, manufactured by Textile Marking Machine Co., Inc., Syracuse N. Y. The tape is $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide and 1 1/16" long and bears letters and numbers O2B-6.

Experts at Textile Marking Machine Company advise type on this machine is unusual in that the first two characters are 15 point type and the last three characters are 18 point type, with the middle character, the letter B, probably being narrow rather than regular type. The usual machine carries 15 point type for the first three characters and 18 point type for the last two characters

Textile Marking Machine experts also stated this machine is defective in that it is producing a tape $1\ 1/16$ " long instead of $1\ 1/8$ " long and is not projecting the tape far enough resulting in cutting off a portion of the first letter. The code used in the Northeast part of the U. S. is as follows:

The first letter O stands for lot number; the first number 2 indicates the day of the week, two being Tuesday; the second letter indicates the first letter of the store name, this is the letter B; the last number is the bundle number, this is 6 Color coding of the tag may designate various things such as a different month or the identity of a store in a chain. Experts also state the use of this system on laundry items is unusual in that the system is normally used on garments being dry cleaned

The Bureau has instructed that all textile machines using this type tape be located and machines using this code be identified.
